

# Lazybead Scarf

Simple scarves using pre-beaded silk yarn...no stringing required!  
Knit version (left) by Tracy Keeter. Crochet version (right) by Sherri Torrez.



Yarn:	Tools:	Gauge:
Sweaterkits Silk Jewel, 100% silk with beads, DK, 273 yards	Knit: US #9 circular or straight needles Crochet: L11/8mm hook, 2 stitch markers	Knit: 5 st = 1" Crochet: 7 st = 4"

## **Knit version, stitches and abbreviations:**

**S11 wyif:** Move yarn to front and slip one stitch purlwise from left needle to right (without knitting it)

**YO:** yarn over

**k2tog:** Knit two stitches together (a decrease of 1 stitch)

## **Instructions:**

With size 9 needle, cast on 22 stitches. Knit 1 row, then begin as follows:

Row 1: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 4 times, yo, K12 (23sts)

Row 2 (**and all even rows**): S12 wyif, knit to end

Row 3: S11 wyif, K1 (yo, k2tog) 5 times, yo, K11 (24sts)

Row 5: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 5 times, yo, K12 (25sts)

Row 7: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 6 times, yo, K11 (26sts)

Row 9: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 6 times, yo, K12 (27sts)

Row 11: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 7 times, yo, K11 (28sts)

Row 13: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 7 times, yo, K12 (29sts)

Row 15: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 8 times, yo, K11 (30sts)

Row 17: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 8 times, yo, K12 (31sts)

Row 19: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 9 times, yo, K11 (32sts)

Row 21: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 9 times, yo, K12 (33sts)

Row 23: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 10 times, yo, K11 (34sts)

Row 25: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 10 times, yo, K12 (35sts)

Row 27: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 11 times, yo, K11 (36sts)

Row 29 & 31: S11 wyif, K1, (yo, k2tog) 12 times, K10 (no inc or dec)

Row 33: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 11 times, K11 (35sts)

Row 35: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 10 times, K12 (34sts)

Row 37: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 10 times, K11 (33sts)

Row 39: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 9 times, K12 (32sts)

Row 41: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 9 times, K11 (31sts)

Row 43: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 8 times, K12 (30sts)

Row 45: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 8 times, K11 (29sts)

*(cntd. on back)*

**Knit version, cntd. from front:**

Row 47: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 7 times, K12 (28sts)

Row 49: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 7 times, K11 (27sts)

Row 51: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 6 times, K12 (26sts)

Row 53: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 6 times, K11 (25sts)

Row 55: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 5 times, K12 (24sts)

Row 57: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 5 times, K11 (23sts)

Row 59: S11 wyif, k2tog, (yo, k2tog) 4 times, K12 (22sts)

Repeat these 60 rows 7 times, or until you are nearly out of yarn, ending on row 60. Bind off. Block as desired to open up lace.

The finished size of our piece after blocking is 8" at the widest part by 84" long.

**Crochet version, stitches and abbreviations:**

Ch = chain; Sc = single crochet

Note: Please do not skip the locking stitch marker step. That last loop can be tricky to pick up. Gauge is not critical, but you want your stitches very loose so that the piece has good drape.

**Instructions:**

Chain 51.

Row 1: 1 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook and in each ch to the end. Ch 3, turn. (50 sc)

Row 2: 2 sc in the 2nd ch from the hook. Place locking stitch marker in the 1st sc made. 1 sc in the next ch, 1 sc in each sc to the end. Ch 3, turn. (53 sc)

Repeat Row 2 until you are almost out of yarn. (Each row will add 3 sc.)

Cut yarn and weave in ends.

Block to desired measurements. Our finished piece measured 90" from tip to tip and 9" across at the widest point.
