Knit pattern: Iris Schreier. Crochet pattern: Mitzi Thomas. Yarn dyed exclusively for LoopsClub by ArtYarns!



Yarn:	Tools:	Gauge:
Merino Cloud merino/cashmere 436 yds + Beaded Silk & Sequins Light 25 yds	Knit: #10 circular needles 24-36" Crochet: J-6mm hook	Knit: 3.5 sts & 6 rows=1"x1" in SS Croc: 18 st=4" in linen stitch
<p>Note: Find lots more photos and alternate pattern ideas in the Spoiler thread of Ravelry group "Loopalicious"!</p> <p>Crochet Pattern (shown above right) With Yarn A (Merino Cloud), chain 246 PM in 245th chain</p> <p>Row 1: dc in 4th ch from hook *sk 1 ch, dc in next ch, ch 1* repeat from *, join with a sl st in marked ch being careful not to twist. You can stitch up the edge in finishing stages as you weave in ends.</p> <p>Row 2: ch 3 (counts as 1st hdc) *hdc in ch1 sp, ch 1* repeat from *, join with a sl st in top of ch 3</p> <p>Row 3: Repeat row 2</p> <p>Row 4: ch 2 (counts as 1st sc) *sc in ch1 sp, ch 1* repeat from * join with a sl st in top of ch 3</p> <p>Rows 5- 20: Repeat row 4. <i>Note: If you want to be sure your beaded row is exactly in the middle of your cowl, weigh your yarn to determine when you have used half of the Merino Cloud.</i></p> <p>Row 21: (eyelet row) With yarn B (beaded yarn) ch 3, *dc in next ch1 sp, ch 1* repeat from *, join with a sl st in top of ch 3</p> <p>Rows 22-38 Change to yarn A and repeat row 4</p> <p>Rows 39 and 40: Repeat row 2</p> <p>Row 41: ch 3, *sk 1 ch, dc in next ch1 sp, ch 1* repeat from *, join with a sl st in top of ch 3. Fasten off, join beginning edge and weave in ends. Block and enjoy! Finished length of our piece was 50 inches. (over for knit pattern)</p>		

Knit Pattern (shown on front page, left) Finished size after blocking: 64" wide x 15" deep

Instructions:

With Yarn A (Merino Cloud), cast on 3 sts

Work Garter Tab as follows:

Knit 10 rows. Turn and pick up and knit into 5 purl bumps along side, then pick up and knit along 3 cast on sts—11 sts total

Setup row: With A, K3, yo, k1, kfb, k1, kfb, k1, yo, k3

Next row: With A, K3, p to last 3 sts, k3

Ring 1: Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k1, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 2: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3

Row 3: With A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 4: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3

Row 5: With A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 6: K3, k to last 3 sts, k3

Ring 2 Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k2, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: As Ring 1

Ring 3 Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k3, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: As Ring 1

Ring 4: Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k4, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: As Ring 1

Ring 5: Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k5, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: Same as Ring 1

Row 7: Attach Yarn B (Beaded Silk & Sequins Light). With B, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 8: With Yarn B, K3, k to last 3 sts, k3. Cut B.

Row 9: With Yarn A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 10: K3, k to last 3 sts, k3

Ring 6: Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k6, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 2: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3

Row 3: With A, k3, yo, (k7, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 4: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3

Row 5: With A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 6: K3, k to last 3 sts, k3

Row 7: Attach Yarn B. With B, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 8: With B, K3, k to last 3 sts, k3. Cut B.

Row 9: With Yarn A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 10: With A, K3, k to last 3 sts, k3

Ring 7: Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k8, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 2: K3, p to last 3 sts, k3

Row 3: With A, k3, yo, (k9, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 4-10: As Ring 6

Ring 8: Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k10, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: As Ring 1

Ring 9: Row 1: With A, k3, yo, (k11, yo) as many times as fit to last 3 sts, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: As Ring 1

Ring 10:

Row 1: With A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: As Ring 1

Ring 11:

Row 1: With A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Rows 2-6: As Ring 1

Row 7: With A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 8: K3, k to last 3 sts, k3

Row 9: With A, k3, yo, k to last 3 sts, yo, k3

Row 10: K3, k to last 3 sts, k3

Bind off all sts loosely with A as follows: K2, transfer both sts to left needle, ssk, *k1, bind off 1, k1, transfer both sts to left needle, ssk; Repeat from * across shawl until all stitches are bound off. Cut yarn. Weave in ends. Block by dampening and pinning out to desired measurements. Let dry before moving.
