

# Starlet

Knit pattern by Sasha Ball Rives. Crochet pattern by Mitzi Thomas



Yarn:	Tools:	Gauge:
Knit Collage "Starlet," 100% silk plied with Lurex, 100g/220yds x 2 skeins	Knit: US 7, 9 & 10.5 24" circular needles Crochet: Size K (6mm) hook	Knit: 13 sts & 22 rows on #9 in SS Crochet: 10 sc = 4"

## Knit Pattern (shown in lavender S/M, above left)

### Abbreviations:

St(s) = stitch(es)

K = knit

PM = place marker; SM = slip marker

KFB = knit in front & back of stitch (an increase)

K2Tog = knit 2 together (a decrease)

YO = yarn over

{ } = indicates repeat of pattern

[ ] = indicates instruction for Large/XL size

**Note:** If you would like to add fringe to the finished piece, reserve 30 [36] pieces of 16" long fringe to apply later.

**Directions:** Using size 7 needles, Cast On 110 [144] sts.

Join for working in the round, PM and Knit 10 rows.

Next Row: (Knit 10 [11], KFB), repeat to end of row.

120 [156] sts.

Switch to size 9 needles

**Setup Row:** (K 10 [12], PM, K 14, PM), repeat to end of row.

**Pattern Row:** (KFB, Knit to 2 sts before marker, K2tog, SM, (YO, K2Tog) 7 times, SM), repeat to end of row.

Repeat this row until pieces measures 11" [9"]

Change to size 10.5 needles.

Continue working pattern row until pieces measures 15" [12"]

Edging Row: (YO, K2Tog) repeat to end of row.

Knit one row.

Bind off loosely and weave in ends.

Apply 3 pieces of fringe to each bottom corner of mesh panels with crochet hook. To keep fringe from unraveling, you may want to knot each strand at the bottom, or apply Fray-Chek. Block and enjoy! Remember, if you wet block the silk yarn, take some extra time when you submerge it to make sure it gets evenly wetted, to avoid spots!

Finished size: 30" [40"] top circumference; 18"[14"] depth

## **Crochet Pattern (shown in port)**

### **Abbreviations:**

sl st = slip stitch  
sc = single crochet  
ea = each  
ch = chain  
dc = double crochet  
sk = skip  
ch sp = chain space

### **Directions:**

With Starlet yarn and Size K (6mm) hook (or size needed to obtain gauge), Ch 80

Round 1: Join with sl st being careful not to twist. Ch 1, pm, sc in ea st around, join with a sl st at marker.

Round 2: Ch 1, pm, sc in next 6 sts, 2 sc in next st, \*sc in next 6 sts, 2sc in next st\*, rep from \* 10x. Sc in next 4 sts, join w/ sl st at marker. (92 sts)

Round 3: Ch 3, pm, \*dc in next 4 sc, 2 dc in next sc\*, rep from \* 17x. Dc in next 2 sts, join w/ sl st at marker. (110 sts)

Round 4: Ch 3, pm, \*dc in next 9dc, 2 dc in next dc\* rep from \*10x. Join in the top of ch 3 w/ sl st at marker. (121 sts)

Round 5: Ch 4, pm in 3rd ch, sk 1 dc, 1 dc in next dc, \*ch 1, sk 1 dc, 1 dc in next dc\* rep across. Ch 1, sk 1 dc, sl st in to 3rd ch at marker to join.

Round 6: Ch 4, pm in 3rd ch, sk 1 dc, 1 dc in next dc, \*ch 1, sk ch sp, 1 dc in next dc\* rep across. Ch 1, sk 1 ch sp, sl st into 3rd ch at marker to join.

Rep Round 6 - 18 more times. Cut and weave in ends.

Add 6" fringe by cutting 3 - 12" pieces of yarn for each section of fringe and attach to bottom of caplet into a ch 1 sp. You can add as much, as little, or no fringe as you like. Model has 12 fringe tassels.
