
All of our sarongs can be hand washed or machine washed at 30°. Do not tumble dry, air naturally.

BUNNY SKIRT





STEP 1 Hold the sarong at two corners and place behind the body




- STEP 2 With each hand, gather two 'bunny ears' about 10" on each side
- STEP 3 Swing fabric around waist to fit, adjusting the length by gathering and folding it over
- STEP 4 With the 'ears' in each hand, fold them over and loosely tie with a double knot
- STEP 5 Slide the knot around the the side or back


HALTERNECK





STEP 1 Hold the sarong at two corners and place behind the body





- STEP 2 Take each corner and put it over the opposite shulder
- STEP 3 Gather the two corners behind the neck and tie securely
- STEP 4 Leave full length or use a belt to cinch the waist or to reduce the length


MILLIONAIRE DRESS



How To Wear Guide

STEP 1 Hold the sarong at two corners





STEP 2 Fold in half and tie the two new corners together





STEP 3 Open the two sides up, place arms through the two holes and wear like a waistcoat

Once the sarong is being worn as a jacket, line up each edge to meet at the belly button



STEP 5 Gather all the spare silk from behind the body and form two 'bunny ears' at the waist


STEP 6 Feed the two 'ears' through the buckle and tie tightly in front of the belly button




ONE SHOULDER DRESS



How To Wear Guide



STEP 2 Take one corner under the arm and pull over the shoulder



- STEP 3 Hold in place and wrap the rest of the sarong snugly around the back of the body
- STEP 4 Bring the fabric around to the front under the same arm
- STEP 5 Adjust the silk so the two ends can be tied in a knot over the shoulder
- Tuck any spare silk underneath



SKINNY HALTERNECK





STEP 1 Hold the sarong at two corners and place behind the body



- $^{\rm STEP~2}$ Take each corner and pull out in front the body, tie together and pull in towards the bust
- STEP 3 Twist each end round and round
- STEP 4 Once secure, pull behind the neck and tie with a small knot

STRAPLESS DRESS





- STEP 1 Hold the sarong at two corners and place behind the body
- STEP 2 Hold each corner out in front the body
- STEP 3 Feed each end through the two holes in the buckle and ease back to the centre of the bust



- STEP 4 Fold each strap behind the body, left and right
- STEP 5 Tuck the straps into your bikini or tie behind the body in a small knot
- STEP 6 Once secure, fold the front panels over each other

STRAPLESS BOW DRESS





STEP 1 Hold the sarong at two corners and place behind the body



- STEP 2 Hold each corner out in front the body and tie the two ends together, securing it on the bust
- STEP 3 Tie the two ends into a bow and arrange the front to drape over one another

STRAPLESS BOW BACK DRESS





STEP 1	Hold the sarong at two corners and	place behir	nd the body

- STEP 2 Hold each corner out in front of the body and tie the two ends together, securing it on the bust
- STEP 3 Tie the two ends into a bow and arrange the front to drape over one another
- Arrange the sarong so that the bow is directly at the back of the body

MINI DRESS



How To Wear Guide

STEP 1 Hold the sarong at two corners





STEP 2 Fold in half and tie two corners together





- STEP 3 Open the two sides up, place arms through the two holes and wear like a waistcoat
- STEP 4 Once the sarong is being worn as a jacket, gather the silk loosely around the waist
- STEP 5 Pick up the 'saddlebags' at the widest part and pull up to waist height
- STEP 6 Fold the two ends in front of the body and loosely tie into a knot on your waist
