Scania Highline Fridge Trailer - Stobart Super League All Teams

Stobart Group partnered with the Super League in a cross-marketing deal to secure title-naming rights to rugby league's elite club competition during 2012. Each of the 14 clubs had trailers branded with images of their players and team colours to help promote the sport.

As of last month Oxford released their 1:76 scale Scania Highline Fridge Trailer with the first 5 teams, followed this month with the remaining 9 teams (see pages 2-3) and the final 'All Team' livery. This final model shown here contains all previous 14 teams together on one truck.

Features to the models include; the name of the individual club, unique 2012 registration plate, fleet & trailer numbers & most importantly for Stobart fans the girls' names on the radiator.

The AEC Matador was used extensively by all the Armed Forces and this latest Oxford military release in RAF blue-grey comes as an authentically researched flatbed variant. The RAF serial numbers RAF 182426 feature on

the rear and the sides, with the RAF roundel and B/I designation featuring on the sides of the bonnet and above the rear wheels. The interior is black and the exterior detail extends to the realistic 'planking' on the trailer floor.

Spitfire MkI - Pre-WWII. 19 Squadron. RAF

19 Squadron was the first flying squadron of the RAF to receive the Spitfire Mkl in August 1938. The squadron history is an interesting one, going

back as far as September 1915, during which time it saw

service in WWI, right across Europe. Following the end of the Great War, the Squadron was disbanded but reformed in 1924 at Duxford. Here it remained during the inter-war years, flying a variety

of bi-plane fighters until the arrival of their Spitfires.

Our Oxford 1:72 scale example is typical of the prewar delivery of Spitfires to No. 19 Squadron.

Decorated in the brown and green camouflage scheme, with silver (aluminium) underside, its number K9694

features on the sides and underbelly. The two-blade propeller has the detailed yellow tips and the exhaust pipes in front of the cockpit have been given an authentic rust brown finish. The rudder

carries the No. 19 on both sides and the RAF roundel in red, white and blue is printed on the underside. Note especially the extra band of yellow in the roundel on the top of the wings, which is totally accurate for this particular pre-war plane. This was to identify it more clearly against the camouflage colour scheme but once WWII broke out, it was gradually phased out because it became too conspicuous, particularly in the face of the enemy.



Volvo FH Fridge Trailer - H. E. Payne

H E Payne (Transport) Ltd found its roots back in 1938 when Harry Edward Payne began work as a coal merchant with a Morris Commercial 30 cwt truck. working out of Tempsford railway station in Bedfordshire. He capitalised on a local lack of transportation during WWII by providing a service to farmers,

getting their produce to market. The company, headed up by Harry's son David, together with his son Richard - has run a variety of haulage vehicles over the years. Volvo FH

fridge vehicles form a large part of the fleet, operating from their 5-acre site at Wyboston, Bedfordshire.

Volvo FH Curtainside - WH Malcolm

Donald Malcolm was just 14 when he inherited the family business in the 1940s. Its assets were a single truck and a horse and cart. By 1960, when the firm was acquired by Grampian Holdings, Donald had built it up to a fleet of 37 vehicles - plus seven items of plant.

In January 2002, Grampian Holdings plc was renamed The Malcolm Group plc and was fully listed on the UK Stock



Exchange, before being taken private again by the Malcolm family in 2005. This model has the registration SF09 DWY.

Armstrong Siddeley Hurricane - 'Bluebird' Blue [Malcolm Campbell] Closed top

The Hurricane was a two-door, four seat drophead coupé made by Armstrong Siddeley Motors between 1946 and 1953. Our model is a replica of the car owned by Sir Malcolm Campbell, the land speed record holder, who had its paint scheme in 'Bluebird Blue' especially commissioned. Following his death in 1948, the car passed through a further two owners before being abandoned in the 1960s. Forty years later it was sold to a Swiss enthusiast who is now restoring it.

You can have your own authentic little Oxford replica, full of detail and refinements. Modelled with the hood in the raised position and with its non-opening 'suicide doors', the body and wheels are painted in blue, with silver wheel inserts. The 'canvas' hood is beige, a colour also used for the seats, floor covering and door panels. The interior

decoration also includes a white steering wheel, a brown dashboard, sun visors and floor cappings. Other details include a wealth of chrome work and the Armstrong Siddeley badge is particularly impressive. It is a great little model from the 1940s and its real-life provenance makes it an even more interesting one to collect.

Bentley Continental Fastback – Gunmetal Grey

Oxford continues the issue of highly detailed prestige cars with this latest release on the Bentley Continental Fastback. Its sloping back gives it a real streamlined and elegant appearance in the conservative Gunmetal colour scheme, relieved by lots of silver 'chrome' to doors, window surrounds, bumpers and front grille. The exterior also sports a very fine Bentley badge on the boot lid, along with a GB sticker. The interior is exceptionally plush too! The detailed dashboard and door cappings are finished in a satinised brown and the steering wheel is black. Door panels and front and rear seating come in golden brown

SCALE PRICE BCF004 and the floor/carpets are given a pale satin finish. This new Bentley, registered TLC 389, will complement admirably your fleet of prestige cars of the 1950s. We are sure you will give it some TLC of your own!

Morris Minor Lowlight (MM) - Maroon

The 'Moggy Minor' is one of the UK's most iconic cars ever produced. Designed by Sir Alec Issigonis, who went on to design the Mini, the Morris Minor was introduced in 1948. Between its debut at the Earls Court Motor Show in September of that year and 1971 when the last rolled off the British production line, an amazing 1,368,291 had been made at the Morris Works in Oxford.

Our model is a replica of the original Minor MM saloon, a two-door version which featured the headlights set in the radiator section of the front, covering the period between 1948 and 1952. Later versions had the headlights set into the front wings.

Authentic features on our little model include original headlight configuration, the split windscreen, a detailed chrome radiator grille and an intricate badge above the radiator. Registered CCF 703, the number plate is printed in silver out of black. The wheels have a maroon insert and the front bumpers replicate the authentic split format with the two chrome sections separated by a maroon centre section. Rear lights are printed in red, while the extensive chrome masking on the front, sides and rear are in sharp contrast to the maroon bodywork. In 1:76 scale, it is a delightfully compact little replica, which would also enhance a landscaped railway scene of the 1950s era

Burlingham Sunsaloon – A & C McLennan

The Scottish operator A & C McLennan, with a striking dark blue and white liveried fleet, was a well-known independent Perthshire based coach and bus company until it passed to Stagecoach in the 1970s. Our model is a replica of their Burlingham coach, HDK 802, seen here

heading for Blairgowrie. The two tone dark blue and white exterior has contrasting pale blue interior seating and also comes with a wealth of silver 'chromework' for a replica of this size, including wheel trims, fuel filler cap, window surrounds, headlights and sidelights, radiator surround and windscreen wipers.













Our 1:76 scale model is decorated in the familiar Devon General red and cream colour scheme. The graphics in gold show it as belonging to the Engineers Department. The vehicle carries trade plates 199TT in red out of white on the front and the back. Also printed in white on the offside front bonnet section is a TOWING notice, alerting other road users to the job in hand. The fuel tank, door handles, tow bar and lights are

masked silver. The rear flatbed section has realistic brown 'planking' – an area that also houses the crane, complete with hook and our detailed model is finished with a roof beacon on the top of the cream cab roof.

a decade after its foundation. This book tells the full story of this internationally desirable brand from the beginning to the modern era under ownership of the VW Group.




































































Leyland Car Transporter -Lincolnshire Steam & Vintage Rally
