Scania Highline Walking Floor - Eddie Stobart

Our Scania Highline truck with newly tooled trailer, registered PX10 EKR, comes in the very modern and intricately detailed Eddie Stobart Biomass livery in their signature colours of white, red and green. The tractor unit has a black chassis with red mudguards and black masking to radiator grille, mirrors and sun visor while the trailer chassis is red with black mudguards and features a green roof. The back doors are painted white and are printed with the Eddie Stobart Biomass graphics. Other fine details include the girls' names printed on the front

above the radiator and again above the front wheel arch of the cab. The cab interior is black.

The innovative walking floor facility comprises a hydraulically-driven moving floor conveyance system for moving materials in all sorts of situations but in this case, Eddie Stobart have taken the concept to aid loading and unloading goods to and from their haulage vehicles. As well as saving manpower, it also takes much less time and dispenses with the need for a forklift. Although our model cannot incorporate all the internal features of the slatted floor sections and movable front wall, the external features are a true replica of the real thing.

Scania Highline Fridge - Eddie Stobart

You will recall we launched the I:148 Scania Highline cab in Issue I70 with a curtainside trailer in Eddie Stobart livery.
The second release comes as a Scania Highline Fridge, also in a modern Eddie Stobart livery. This time, the model incorporates a refrigeration unit for its use in Temperature Controlled Distribution and is decorated

in white with red and green graphics with silver grey roof to the trailer, registered PH13 HNL. The truck has a high level of detailed graphics for its size,



which extend across the back doors. It will make a fine addition to any N gauge modern truck diorama.

OXFORD MILITARY 1:76



Allies on all fronts during WWII. The Bedford OY was one of these and we see it here for the first time with a tanker body with single rear wheels, as used by the Royal Army Service Corps in North Africa in 1942. It is appropriately decorated in an overall desert beige, repeated on

the wheel inserts, with black masking to hoses and front grille. White markings and lettering feature along the sides and front of the bonnet and across the tanker back, with additional military identity insignia printed in red, green and black. The

interior is olive green with black steering wheel. The 1:76 scale model is another authentic addition to the Oxford Military series of WWII vehicles.

Dingo Scout Car - Polish 10th Mounted Rifles **Armoured Cavalry Brigade, England**

This is the second release on the newly tooled Scout Car which we launched in Issue 169 and is a replica of the British light fast four-wheel drive reconnaissance vehicle, known in service as the Dingo after the Australian wild dog. It was a two-man armoured car also used in a liaison role during WWII and this release represents a vehicle which was used by the Polish 10th Armoured Cavalry Brigade, an armoured formation of the Polish Armed Forces in the west. It was initially organised in France where Polish troops had formed a new army fighting alongside the French, following the invasion of Poland by the Nazis. It took part in the Battle of France in 1940. However, everything changed in France too following the German invasion and the Brigade war recreated in Great Britain when the remnants of the Polish fighting force escaped to England.

Our model is based on the Dingo Scout Car used by the Polish AC Brigade once they re-established in England. Note the PL designation on the back. Painted in a muddy brown with a chassis the same colour, the military numbering is printed white with the Brigade identity markings in red and white, Additional detail comprises grey aerial cage and fuel cans with light brown fuel can straps, black aerials and aerial bases and rust coloured exhausts.

Jaguar F Type - Ebony Black

The new Jaguar F Type is considered the spiritual successor of the famous E-Type. Our 1:76 scale model, registered FL13 WFF is decorated in Ebony Black with matt black interior with light ivory seats. The distinctive spoked wheels have also been faithfully reproduced, masked in silver, as have the twin exhausts, side vents and radiator grille surround. The Jaguar badge in the centre of the radiator, also masked in silver, rounds off this replica of a prestige marque.





Jaguar XF - Carnelian Red Metallic

The Jaguar XF, designed by lan Callum, was originally launched in 2007. Our XF is based on the 2013 specification of the four-door saloon and comes in Metallic. Registered FL13 WFB, the all-over Carnelian Red colour scheme, with black interior and seating, is complemented by silver masking to the spoked wheels,

distinctive front grilles and exhausts, while door pillars and chassis are also matt black. A superb brand new Oxford model

Jaguar XJ Saloon - Stratus Grey

Another great introduction to Oxford's Jaguar stable is the new XJ luxury car. With a 2013 specification, our replica features the new look exterior of the real thing. It has slimmer, sleeker lights and a larger, squarer grille. Observe too, the upright swooping tail lights nicknamed 'cat's claws'. Registered SA13 GZL, the elegant Stratus Grey exterior bodywork with black chassis also has black door pillars and wipers. The interior is also black with ivory seats.





Jaguar XK Convertible - Polaris White

Jaguar's designer lan Callum has also been responsible for this latest model. Oxford have chosen to model the latest 2013 specification on the convertible, which comes in open-top mode in a gleaming white, registered LS13 XMX. The interior is grey blue, including steering wheel, floor and seats. The leaping Jaguar and the letters XK feature on the back while the famous Jaguar badge sits in the centre of the front grille, which in itself is very reminiscent of the 1961 E-type. A very classy motor indeed!

Jaguar XKR-S - French Racing Blue

Here at Oxford, we have tooled up the 2013 specification 2-door coupé version of the XKR-S for our first release in an eye-catching French Racing Blue with contrasting black chassis and completely black interior. Silver masking has also been applied to side vents, exhaust pipes and the sporty wheels. Any Jaguar car enthusiast will be delighted and impressed at Oxford's extensive new tooling and we look forward to bringing you some further superb new introductions.






Austin Hearse - White

Our newly tooled Austin Princess Hearse in 1:43 scale was launched recently in the traditional black colour scheme but our second introduction in an angelic white is equally authentic, being popularly used for West Indian funerals. Registered DLM 519C, much of the intricate detail is in the interior. The front features a brown

dashboard top, dashboard panel and door cappings in brown, while the steering wheel, door panels, door cappings, seats, floor and 'carpet' are black. To the rear, the side panels and seats are black; with the load bed, floor/carpet and door cappings moulded in brown. We should add that you'll have to source your own deceased occupant and coffin!





Bedford OX Booking Office - Billy Smart's

Fans can add another Billy Smart's Circus vehicle to their 1:76 scale big top diorama with this highly decorative and original Booking Office.

The Bedford OX was a short-wheelbase version of the Bedford OY, designed for a 30 cwt payload and often linked to a semi-trailer, as our model shows, comprising a trailer back without a front axle but supported by the tractor unit axle. The Bedford OX is used to its full

potential on our model of an advanced booking office. The bodywork is decorated in two tone pale and darker green with the whole of the trailer cleverly masked and printed to make it look as if it has windows, a door and a kiosk towards the rear section with a finely printed and colourful poster. The cab has dark green mudguards and wheel inserts,

A modification to the tooling adds two speakers to the roof in silver. The main bodywork is orange and

black dropped shadow printing. An unusual model to add to your circus field.

MINI Coupé - Pepper White and Chilli Red

BMW's new MINI Coupé can be described in two words style and fun. The racy bodyshape and colour schemes will appeal to many for whom the two-seater limitation is not an issue, although the price might be, at between £16,000 and £26,000. We launch our newly tooled 1:76 scale replica with one of the outstanding colourways and it is more affordable! In Pepper White with the sporty Chilli Red stripe running down over the boot and along the bonnet, reversed to Pepper White on the red roof, even the wing mirrors are finished in the contrasting colour. Registered GL12 XEO, it is

relatively recent off the production line and looks outstanding in Oxford model form. With black chassis, wheel arches, window surrounds and steering wheel, all remaining trim is in silver. Additional detail includes the John Cooper Works logo finely printed on the rear and the MINI badge above the radiator.

The 1960s were a great period in British Rallying/Racing and this set centres on the 1969 Tour de France Automobile with three Classic Mini Cooper S Mk.II models, all decorated in red with white roof. The names of the drivers, all racing legends are printed on the sides of each car alongside the Union Flag.

Car No. 12, registered URX 550G, is as driven by Brian Culcheth and team-mate Johnstone Syer. Car No. 56,URX 560G was the drive of John Handley and Paul Easter;

and Car No. 57, registered OBL 45L had Paddy Hopkirk and Tony Nash thrashing it out.

Although the race was won that year by the French, with a Porsche 911R, the British Minis proved they were a match for anything and this set is a great souvenir of that great motorsport period.

Range Rover Evoque - Fuji White

Another new vehicle to enter the Oxford range is the latest Range Rover - the Evoque. Our model is a replica of the three-door coupé with 2013 specification, painted in pristine Fuji White. Registered AY13 NLZ, it incorporates the detailed features of the real thing, including the new alloy wheel style, as well as a new style Land Rover badge in the front grille and tailgate. Note too, the distinctive RR clamshell shaped bonnet, dual pocket headlights, 'floating' roof and raked roofline. External trim to door pillars, bumpers and window surrounds is finished in

black, with remaining masking in silver. A final touch sees the Range Rover lettering in silver along the front edge of the bonnet and along the back below the window, with 'Evoque' added to the left of the rear number plate.





Reliant Regal Super Van 3 - Royal Mail

The Reliant Regal is an unusual vehicle to be used by the Royal Mail and will be an equally different addition to any Royal Mail model line-up. Registered EMF 22J, the Royal Mail insignia on the side doors indicated it as being allocated to the Post Office in Scunthorpe. The Post Office red paintwork is offset by lots of silver masking to side and rear door handles, headlights and the front badge.

The chassis is black and the wheel inserts are masked in cream, whilst the interior is moulded in red.

Ford Fiesta Mk 1 - Jasmine Yellow

The Ford Fiesta was a zippy little hatchback launched in the mid 1970s and proved a highly popular little car. It was superseded by the Mk.II in 1983. Our recently tooled 1:76 scale model has already appeared in Venetian Red and Nevada Beige and this third release comes in bright yellow, registered SNN 492X. Silver trim emphasises door handles, headlights, bumpers, wheels and exhaust while additional trim is finished in black. The Fiesta marque is also printed in silver on the nearside rear while the Ford badge appears in blue and silver on the front of the radiator. Additional detail also extends to the light clusters; the rear lights are printed in orange and red, while the front lights are orange and silver.


