ST001 Sunbeam Talbot 90 MkHa – Black

New tooling in this popular scale extends the fleet of Oxford Diecast saloon cars from the 1950s and 1960s with a superb example of the Sunbeam Talbot 90 MkIIa. Many of us no doubt remember our older - and perhaps more affluent - relatives owning a Sunbeam Talbot, which was very stylish for its day with its sweeping lines.

The MKIIa was made between 1952 and 1954 and succeeded the MkII, which will release over the next few months - another new Oxford introduction. The MkIIa had a higher compression engine, raising output to 77 bhp. To cater for the higher speeds you could achieve in this upgraded car,

the manufacturers – the Rootes Group - enlarged the brakes, as well as piercing the wheels to improve the brake cooling. The integral rear wheel spats were no longer featured either. Almost 11,000 were made over the two years of manufacture – twice the number for the earlier MkII version. Our newly launched model comes in black with chrome trim. Very smart!

VFE004 Vauxhall Cresta Friary Estate -Swan White/Lime Yellow

This latest colourway on the 1:43 scale Oxford Vauxhall Cresta Friary Estate car is amazing – and authentic, even down to the interior co-ordinated 'leather' upholstery! Produced between the 1950s and 1970s, it was the UK take on the American cars of the era and oozed confidence, making it a favourite for

rock stars and the like. Questionably elegant, it proved a little

garish for the upmarket professionals, although HM the Queen sported a plain dark green version. And - as you can see - it had masses of room in the back. Oxford have reproduced the characteristics of the original excellently, with lots of chrome, eye-catching two-tone colours and detailed interior seating.

Be first on the road with Ford, reads the slogan along the side of this transporter of the 1940s/50s period. This new Oxford model is representative of the era and is in keeping with the 1:76 series of Oxford Automobiles, which you can add as a load, providing a bit of fun as well. And, if you have too many vehicles to transport, couple it to the 76 LTR004T Ford Car Transporter Trailer, with the same red and cream paint scheme, adding interest to a roadscene of the era.

The Land Rover, launched in 1948, was an instant hit and continues to be the workhorse for anyone involved in heavy duty, rural or off-road environment. Its use also extended to public bodies as well, as your collection of previously released Oxford Land Rovers will verify. This latest introduction is as used by the RAF from the late 1940s to the 1970s, complete with RAF military number plate and the RAF roundel on the offside front wing. It looks particularly smart

painted in RAF blue-grey with the striking contrast of chrome grille, bumpers, window surrounds and door hinges. The canvas back is in a realistic

drab olive green, rounding off a delightful little model that would look good on your Oxford Aviation airfield.

Our latest livery on the DAF 105 Super Space Cab represents a special paint job, which Bentons used on their tractor units to celebrate their centenary in 2008. The striking silver and maroon livery is a

distinctive contrast from the trailer, which remained in their standard colours. John William Benton founded the haulage company in 1908 in Lincolnshire, engaged primarily in agricultural and general haulage. His three sons incorporated the company in 1954, following which further expansion saw the company acquiring a 25-acre site at nearby Sibsey in 1968. Steady growth continued into the Millennium with a further move to Immingham and the acquisition of more land in Killingholme in 2003. Today, Benton Brothers (Transport) Ltd employs over 150 personnel at two sites, with 120 tractive units and 250 trailers of all types, enabling them to operate internationally as well as in the home market. The vehicles are all painted in the Company's original livery.


VOL04REC Volvo FH Boniface Recovery Vehicle - W H Malcolm

Originating as a family-owned business in the 1940s, the WH Malcolm Group in Renfrewshire, Scotland has become a leading provider of logistics and construction services, employing assets of over 1600 people, 450 trucks and 1000 trailers, as well as over 120 items of heavy plant, all housed in their 3 million square feet of warehousing throughout the UK.



The Construction Services Division is a one-stop major contractor for groundwork services, waste management and plant and tipper hire. The vehicles used in this division of the company come in the bright blue, green and yellow livery, rather than the more familiar two-tone blue, red and white of the W H Malcolm haulage fleet.

Our model differs slightly from the real thing - W H Malcolm's Recovery Vehicle carries an extra axle. However, the company name is so popular amongst truck enthusiasts and this model is such an unusual addition to the W H Malcolm fleet that we are sure this will not detract from its collectability.

DS007 Daimler Hearse – Black/Claret

This latest 1:43 scale replica – without its occupant - is modelled from a real vehicle, as owned and used by Norwich Funeral Directors, Ivan Fisher Funerals, which is a traditional and independent family run business, serving the whole of Norfolk from its two offices in the county. The rich claret paintwork, coachlines and sweeping chrome finish along the sides of our Oxford replica compliment the gleaming black

effect is completed with more sparkling chrome work, which even extends to the roof rack, whilst the interior features the realistic 'polished' wood to the rear. Wonderfully realistic!



AC015 Kawasaki Ki-61 Hien

Another piece of brand new tooling brings an unusual WWII addition to the Oxford Aviation fleet in the shape of the Kawasaki Ki-61 Hien, nicknamed 'Tony' by the US Air Force.

Decorated in the striking and detailed 'palm leaf front line camouflage livery, this warplane epitomises the detailed and colourful style of Japanese military aircraft of the period, which many of us may not have taken much notice of up to now. Our aircraft represents the Kawasaki Hein (Tony) Ki61 of Kai-Hei of HQ Chutai, 224th Sentai, Chofu, Tokyo over the winter of 1944/45.

The Ki-61 was designed by Takeo Doi and Shin Owada in response to a tender put out by the technical branch of the Imperial Army Air HQ in 1939.

The first design – Ki-60 was for a heavily armed specialised interceptor, whilst the second – and the subject of our Oxford model – was the Ki-61, a more lightly loaded and armed general purpose fighter to be used mainly in an offensive, air superiority

role at low to medium altitudes. It was an all metal, single seat, single engine fighter and took its first flight in December 1941. It was the only mass-produced Japanese warplane to use a liquid-cooled inline V-engine. Over 3000 were built, seeing service first in 1943, mostly in New Guinea – along with combat missions throughout the war until retirement in 1945. One of the negative aspects of the aircraft was the lack of visibility for the pilot, particularly to the rear due to the bulky fuselage behind the cockpit. Used primarily by the IJA Air Force, the Ki-61 was also used by the Chinese Nationalist Air Force and the Indonesian People's Security Force.



76BED004 Bedford J1 Ambulance – St John Ambulance

St John Ambulance, branded as St John in some territories, is a common name used by a number of affiliated organisations in different countries dedicated to the teaching and practice of medical first aid and the provision of ambulance services, all of which derive their origins from the St John Ambulance Association founded in 1877 in the UK, You see them at the majority of events where their volunteers, in their smart uniform, are at the ready to administer medical help to the general public.


76DEF004 Land Rover Defender Station Wagon – Garda

Another Land Rover – the later Defender - takes on the guise of the Garda, the Irish Police Force, with a station wagon long wheelbase version. This is also the fourth release on the Defender in 1:76 scale. In characteristic white with yellow Garda markings along the sides, note the detailed badge on the side doors and light bar on the roof. The vehicle represents the ones introduced in the 1990s, still in use today.






1:76 Scale Oxford Haulage Company DAF10CS – DAF 105 (S) Curtainside – C S Ellis
