Greyfriars Review began publication with one number (volume 1, number 1) in September 1987, followed by volume 2, numbers 1–3 in January, June, and December 1988. This materialized the dream of two Capuchin priests (Regis Armstrong and Patrick Colbourne) to extend to the English-speaking world the goldmine of contemporary Franciscan scholarship mainly through the translation of articles, and occasionally through English articles of special importance. These two catalysts were assisted in the selection of articles by an inter-Franciscan board of men and women (someone has called them “all heavies in their field”) and by the self-sacrifice of equally competent translators. The magazine, initially underwritten by our general superiors, is now under the aegis of the North American Capuchin Conference (of provincials). Three issues are now in preparation for publication in May, September and the end of December 1989.

We have had trouble with the mail. We can only apologize to you, our subscribers, as we try to remedy the situation, and we thank you for your patience.
