Team Reports:

Track/Field: 7 athletes qualified for nationals in the winter, and 1 was able to go. A school record was broken! Close to 150 athletes are showing up daily to train. The throwing program is going well, and the new blocks are wonderful. The Hall of Fame meet is coming up on April 22, and approximately 30 teams will be there (1500-1800 athletes/fans).

Baseball: Varsity is currently undefeated. Two fundraisers are happening tonight. The Battle of the Beltway was held over spring break and Lake Braddock played well and won all their games. Capital One sponsored the entry fee for the tournament. Car Wash fundraisers are being planned, but no dates have been set yet. Senior Night is April 17 and Little League Day is April 28.
