

Bake the lights in the oven at 250*F for 10 minutes. Pry the lens from the housing using a flat headscrewdriver. Dont force this, the lens will separate quite easily. Make sure you bend the tabs back to allow the lens to separate.

You'll also need to remove the bulb reflector from the housing (not pictured).



Using a dremel, you'll need to sand down this ridge until it is flush.



This is the step where you'll want to install of the bulbs (temporarily) and lights on your Fronty (without the lenses) and align the cutoff by twisting the projector. Once you have it where you want it, you can seal them up. Take the included sealant and stretch it out. Place the sealant in the channel of the housing and then reinstall the lens.
