READ THESE TIPS TO MAKE SURE YOU'RE PREPARED

- Test the Leather Honey on a small, discreet area of your leather item to ensure full compatibility of the solution to your leather. This is important - because leather is a natural substance, each piece is unique and thus may react differently to conditioners and cleaners.
- Prepare a space & lay out newspaper, cloth or towel on the floor or table in an outdoor or well-ventilated environment. Avoid exposure to direct sunlight.
- It is recommended to use two cloths for the Conditioner & Cleaner. Once the cloth is saturated with Leather Conditioner, it will be difficult to remove. For this reason, it's not recommended to wash a cloth that has been used with leather conditioner with other items. Simply store the used cloth in the ziplock packaging, to be used again and again without washing.
- Leather Honey deeply penetrates leather and stays there. Try to apply in thin, even coats without over-saturating the leather. Since it does not evaporate or disappear, over saturated pores will continue to excrete the product, which means you'll need to wipe the surface until there is no longer excess.

*Leather Cleaner gently removes dirt, grime and oils from soiled leather. For new leather, Leather Cleaner is not needed. You may use Leather Conditioner directly on item.

LEATHER CLEANER, CONCENTRATED

- 1** Dilute the concentrate: Just mix it with water in a one to eight ratio: One part cleaner (i.e.: two tablespoons) per eight parts (i.e.: one cup) of water.
- 2** Use an application cloth (lint-free preferred) to apply the cleaner onto leather in a thin coat so as not to oversaturate leather - a little goes a long way. Gently rub in circular motion to remove dirt or grime.
- 3** When done, wipe off excess cleaning solution with a clean, soft cotton cloth before leaving the item aside to completely dry naturally.

LEATHER CONDITIONER

- 1** After cleaning, let the leather dry fully. Kill any existing mildew using a combination of apple cider vinegar and water (or white vinegar for lighter/white coloured furniture).
- 2** Use application cloth (lint-free preferred) to apply Leather Honey Leather Conditioner in thin, even coats to the entire surface area of the leather. Remember, a little goes a long way. We recommend that the product be at room temperature or warmer (you can even put it in the microwave or next to a heat source), as it makes it easier to apply.
- 3** Allow time for the Leather Honey to absorb a minimum of two hours, but preferably overnight - and wipe off any excess with the lint-free cloth.
- 4** Let dry. Repeat as many times as necessary.
