## Quick Start

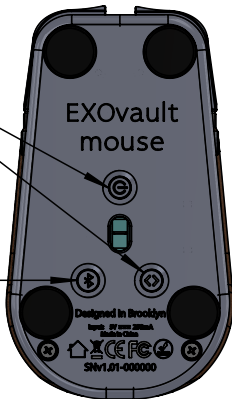
**Power Button**

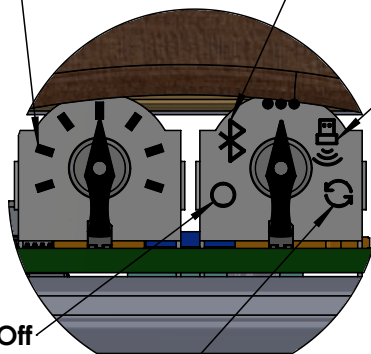

To pair Bluetooth, first, select Bluetooth icon using the connection button. Then press the Bluetooth button. The display points to the pairing icon when pairing mode is entered. When pairing is successful, the indicator points back to the Bluetooth icon.
