



TRAFFIC SAFETY AT CANYON

The convergence of many residential and commuter streets into and around Canyon School, heavy commuter traffic, bikers, joggers, and pedestrians, together with the lack of parking, create **unusual challenges in assuring that every child gets safely to and from school, every day.** No parent should have to worry about the safety of a child because others are ignoring basic safety rules.

Driving Safety: Do not speed. Drive clockwise around campus. NO U-turns.

Parking Safety: Consider parking remotely and walking safely into school. Do not ignore "No Parking" signs and do not park in staff lots.

Pedestrian Safety: Always use crosswalks; NO j-walking. Model good behavior for our students and visitors.

Morning Dropoff Procedures: Kinders may be dropped off in Zone A; all others please pull all the way forward in any of the other zones B, C or D. Do not allow children to exit on the left side of the vehicle, and do not leave your vehicle. Traffic Safety Duty volunteers will help children exit the vehicle.

Afternoon Pickup Procedures: If you are picking up in the Canyon Pick-Up Line, you may only enter the line at the beginning of Zone C, just after the crosswalk on East Channel. Pull all the way forward but do not wait in the red zone. A volunteer will wave you around the corner and into Zone D when there is space to pull forward. Make sure your Canyon Pickup placard with your name is displayed on your dash for the volunteers to read. Students wait just inside the Library Gate and will be called forward when you approach.

Serving Traffic Safety Duty

Every family at Canyon School has a responsibility to participate in Traffic Safety Duty. The duty rotates each week to a different classroom, and you will be notified in the Canyon Chronicle and by your Room Parents when it is your classroom's responsibility, and how to sign up via Signup Genius. Each of our 16 classrooms typically has 2 or 3 weeks of duty per year. There are four zones: A, B, C and D, to which you may be assigned, including a Crosswalk position.

***All Traffic Safety volunteer time slots are assigned. If you are not able to fulfill your obligation at any time, you are responsible to find someone to fill your slot.
