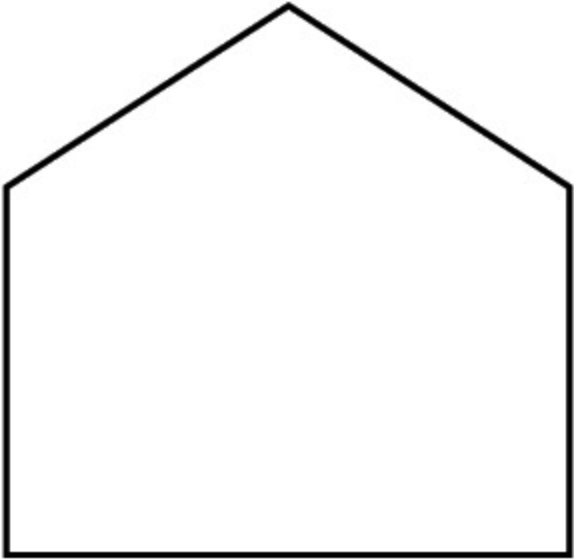

All contractors and subcontractors are to have completed a suitable OH&S induction course (proof/induction card) and have a card to prove their induction.

Safe Work Method Statement (SWMS)

Safe work method statements (SWMS) must be prepared by all workers and subcontractors prior to engaging in any high risk activities.

Trade and Delivery Vehicles

All trade and delivery vehicles are to ensure that they do not block footpaths and do not create hazards for pedestrians and other road users. All delivery drivers are to use the vehicle loading to access this site.

Our Site Rules

- No persons are to enter this site unless prior arrangements have been made with the Builder.
- All Contractors and their subcontractors have current construction induction training evidence (White Card).
- All persons operating plant equipment or performing an activity that requires an operator's license (e.g. scaffolding, excavator, etc.) are required to hold the appropriate license.
- All electricity, dangerous goods, various health injuries, noise hazards and work-related issues must be reported immediately to the Builder.
- No fighting or aggressive behavior will be tolerated.
- Personal protection equipment (PPE) must be worn according to OH&S regulations, where directed by the Builder, whilst operating power tools and in accordance with all OH&S and site signage.
- The Builder is to be advised of any unauthorised work/behaviour. Any unauthorised workers of a nature where they are to be reported immediately and notified if safe to do so and if within the company of the individual.
- Contractors must retain a copy of the RECORD of the workplace for any hazardous substances being used at the workplace.

- The Builder is to be advised of any unauthorised work practices. Any unauthorised workers of a nature where they are to be reported immediately and rectified if safe to do so and if within the competency of the individual.
- Contractors must retain a copy of the WHS of the workplace for any hazardous substances being used at the workplace.

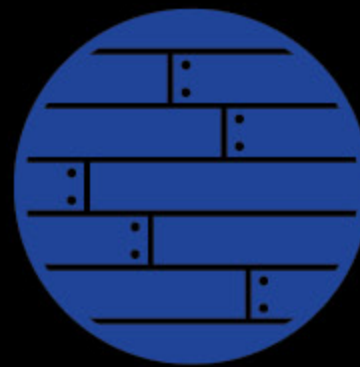
