RAGS-O-LANTERN CARVING STEPS:

1. Get a big round pumpkin (preferably from a local source but we also approve of Trader Joe's).

2. Print off one of the carving templates on the next page.

3. Center the template on said pumpkin and tape the edges down (making sure to not cover any of the design).

4. Using a small nail, golf tee, or another pointy-but-small object, poke holes along the solid black cut lines of the design.


5. When you are done poking holes remove the paper cutouts and tape. The pumpkin will look like it has the chicken pox but do not fret, the holes now show you where to carve.

6. With a small knife or carving tool, follow the hole punches to cut out the design.

7. When you're finished, cut out a hole in the top of the pumpkin and put a candle or other light source inside. Step back to behold your glorious (or not-so-glorious, depending on your skill level) work.



Adult supervision during all of this is not only required it's strongly recommended if you don't want to be haunted by the ghost that lives in the Rags headquarters attic.







1. Print out Frankenstein on thick cardstock paper.


