WIRELESS RADIO SIGNAL

- The 433.92 MHz radio signal passes through walls, windows and doors.
- Indoor range: up to 30 m. Outdoor range: up to 70 m. (optimal conditions)
- The range is strongly dependent on local conditions, such as the presence of metals. For example, the thin metal coating in Low-emissivity (Low-E) glass has a negative impact on the range of radio signals.

MAXIMUM LOAD

Never connect lights or equipment that exceed the maximum load of the receiver, as it can result in defects.

SHOCK HAZARD

Exercise caution when installing a receiver.

Voltage may be present, even when a receiver is switched off.

BATTERY

Remove the battery if the product will not be used for an extended period. Extreme temperatures reduce the capacity and lifetime of the battery. Dispose of batteries according to local regulations. Please recycle when possible.

LIFE-SUPPORT

Never use TRUST SMART Home products for lifesupport systems or other applications in which equipment malfunctions can have life-threatening consequences.

INTERFERENCE

All wireless devices may be subject to interference, which could affect performance. The minimum distance between 2 receivers should be at least 50 cm.

REPAIRING

Do not attempt to repair this product. There are no user-serviceable parts inside.

WATER-RESISTANCE

This product is not water-resistant. Keep it dry. Moisture will corrode the inner electronics and can result in a short circuit, defects and shock hazard.

CLEANING

Use a dry cloth to clean this product. Do not use harsh chemicals, cleaning solvents, or strong detergents.


HANDLING

Remote control

- (1) LED-indicator
- (2) ON/OFF buttons*
- (3) Group OFF button*

*When using an OFF button or the group OFF button the connected light(s)/ device(s) is/are switched off and the receiver is put in stand-by.






Assigning different channels to different receivers

When you would like to control multiple receivers independently, you can assign a desired channel to a specific receiver like depicted above.

Switching multiple receivers to stand-by with the group OFF function

By using the group OFF function (QQQ) you can switch the connected receivers to stand-by. The connected lights and devices will be switched OFF.



1. Connect lamp/device

First check if the lamp or device is turned on. Then plug the lamp or device into the receiver. Do not exceed the maximum load: 1500 W

2a. Assign transmitter code

Placing the receiver into a socket will automatically activate the learn-mode for 5 seconds. The LED-indicator on the receiver will blink slowly. To reactivate the learn-mode, remove the receiver from the socket, wait 10 seconds, then insert the receiver into the socket again.








2b.

Send an ON-signal with any TRUST SMART Home transmitter while the learn-mode is active, to assign the code to the receiver's memory.

2c.

The receiver will switch on/off 2 times to confirm the code has been received. The receiver can store up to 3 different transmitter codes in its memory.

The memory will be preserved when the receiver is moved to another socket or in case of power failure.




3. Manual operation with a transmitter

- 1. Send an ON-signal to switch the receiver on. 2. Send an OFF-signal to put the receiver in stand-by.
- 2. Seria ari off-signal to put the receiver in Stand-by



Single code delete

- 1. Insert the receiver into the socket to activate the learn-mode for 5 seconds.
- 2. While the learn-mode is active, press the [OFF] button of a specific transmitter.
- 3. The receiver will switch on/off 2 times to confirm code deletion.



Full memory delete

- 1. Insert the receiver into the socket to activate the learn-mode for 5 seconds.
- 2. Press the SSS button on the APA3-1500R remote while the learn-mode is active.
- 3. The receiver will switch on/off 2 times to confirm code deletion.
