SPLASH PROOF JUNCTION BOX









#### **OWH-001 SPLASH PROOF JUNCTION BOX**

## 1. Open junction box

Loosen the 4 screws on each corner with a screwdriver and remove the cover plate. The screws are fixed to the cover, so they cannot fall out.

## 2. Position and secure cable glands

Position and secure the cable glands in the position where the wires will be threaded through.

# 3. Switch off mains power

Switch off the mains power (electric meter box) before installing a receiver

#### 4. Connect wires

Connect the wiring as described in the receiver's installation manual. If applicable, connect the earth wires to the terminal block in the corner of the junction box.

#### 5. Position and secure receiver

The receiver can be positioned in 8 different ways, depending on the wiring. Once in position, secure the the receiver with screws.

## 6. Tighten cable glands

Tighten the cable glands by turning clockwise to protect the inside from dust and moist. Use 7-12 mm diameter cables for an optimal seal. Other cable sizes can negatively affect the waterproofness of the junction box.

## 7. Mount junction box

Affix the junction box onto a wall or another surface for extra stability.

## 8. Switch on mains power

Switch on the mains power (electric meter box) to continue the installation Shock hazard! Do not contact any exposed wiring. Only touch the plastic housing of this product.



**9. Assign transmitter** Read the receiver's manual for the code learning procedure.

**10. Close junction box**Put the cover plate back on to the box and tighten the 4 screws on each corner with a screwdriver.
