











To assemble your Guerrilla Bestbuddy[™] chair, make sure you have unpacked all items from the box (see top left).

- 1. Lay the main chair frame on its side and remove the black bumper from the axle bar where the wheel will be mounted. (Bumper is part of packaging only and may be thrown away.) Mount the wheel on the bar.
- 2. Push the hub tab in toward the wheel hub as you push the wheel onto the axel bar. You should feel the wheel click into place.
- 3. Then pull the hub tab out away from the wheel hub. Wheel should be firmly attached to the axle bar.

Repeat steps 1-3 to mount the second wheel on the other side.


- **4.** Open the main chair frame using the red lock on the right side.
- 5. The material that will make up the seat-back is attached to the storage compartment and has two strips of velcro running vertically. Slide this over the frame of the chair. Note: it isn't necessary to remove the inner skeletal frame from the storage compartment to complete this step.
- 6. Place the "lumbar" pillow on the two velcro strips on the seat-back. Because of the length of the strips of velcro on both the seat-back and the lumbar pillow, you can adjust the height of the pillow as necessary for your comfort.
- 7. Adjust the inner skeletal frame by positioning the base flat against the bottom of the storage compartment. You can then criss-cross the two thin metal frames.
- 8/9. There are two strips of velcro sewn under the seam of the top of the storage compartment. Open these up and fold over the thin metal frames to hold them in place. This will give the storage compartment structure.

You are set to go!















*Note: the four black tabs near the handle on the upper part of the chair frame are designed to give umbrellas an extra secure grip!
