MAKE YOUR OWN CANVAS PANEL

- 1. Apply an even layer of adhesive onto your mounting support.
- Quickly apply your canvas to the board. It's faster and easier to work with pieces of oversized canvas, which can be trimmed after

the panel has cured. A brayer is useful for this step. Using moderate pressure, work quickly from one side to the other. You want to push air bubbles out but, be careful not to press so hard that you squeeze the adhesive out the edges.





3. Allow the adhesive to cure under weight for at least 24 hours. A piece of commercial carpet placed between the panel and the weight will protect the surface when mounting a finished painting. Several panels can be prepared in series and stacked one on top of the other.
