

# WINTER GARDEN

- *plant new trees*
- *prune fruit trees in February*
- *prune roses*
- *transplant any herbs*
- *mulch garden beds with compost, straw or seaweed*
- *cut back ornamental grasses & other perennials*
- *mulch crowns of ornamental grasses to protect from cold*
- *order seeds and bare root plants*
- *tidy up garden shed, greenhouse*
- *repair tools*
- *build garden supports from willow or hazel branches*
- *trim and mulch asparagus, rhubarb and artichoke beds*
- *sow in cold frames or flats: onions, summer cabbage, broccoli, celery, kale and brussel sprouts in February*
- *Trim raspberry canes and add manure or mulch*
- *Mulch roses and fertilize roses once they begin to wake up*
