WINTER GARDEN

- plant new trees
- prune fruit trees in February
- prune roses
- transplant any herbs
- mulch garden beds with compost, straw or seaweed
- cut back ornamental grasses & other perennials
- mulch crowns of ornamental grasses to protect from cold
- order seeds and bare root plants
- tidy up garden shed, greenhouse
- repair tools
- build garden supports from willow or hazel branches
- trim and mulch asparagus, rhubarb and artichoke beds
- sow in cold frames or flats: onions, summer cabbage, broccoli, celery, kale and brussel sprouts in February
- Trim raspberry canes and add manure or mulch
- Mulch roses and fertilze roses once they begin to wake up
