Apply to new, dry, pressure-treated wood, uncoated new or weathered wood, or wood previously stained or painted.

LIMITATIONS OF USE

Apply when no precipitation is expected for 12 hours, and when air and surface temperatures are 35°F to below 90°F (2°C to 32°C) and will remain above 35°F (2°C) for the next 24 hours. Avoid staining in direct sunlight.

While this product provides a mildew resistant coating, growth may still occur if the substrate is not properly prepared prior to painting and/or if the substrate is consistently exposed to conditions conducive to mold, mildew, and algae. Examples of these conditions include, but are not limited to, under eaves, behind shrubbery and trees, and in areas that are consistently damp with little to no direct sunlight.

Not recommended for recently painted or sealed surfaces. Do not use on plastic, rubber, asphalt, tile, vinyl, concrete or any non-porous surface.

COVERAGE: Approximately 350 to 500 sq. ft. (32.5 to 46.5 sq. meters) per gallon (3.78 L) depending upon wood texture.

Coverage figures do not include loss due to surface irregularities and porosity or material loss due to application method or mixing.

DRYING TIME: Normally dries to the touch in 30 minutes when applied in optimal temperatures of 50°F to 90°F (10°C to 32°C). Allow 2 to 4 hours between coats or before recoating. Application in high humidity or in temperatures below 50°F (10°C) may prolong drying and recoating times. Allow 24 to 48 hours of drying time before light foot traffic or replacing furniture. Allow new stain to cure 30 days before washing.

CLEANUP: Clean brushes and tools with warm soapy water.

DISPOSAL: Contact your local environmental regulatory agency for guidance on disposal of unused product. Do not pour down a drain or storm sewer.

GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION

Proper surface preparation is essential for the *OLYMPIC* limited warranty to apply. All surfaces must be clean and free of dirt, dust, oil, loose wood fibers, mildew, and other contaminants. Remove grade stamps, pencil marks, etc. by sanding. Remove loose, peeling stain and loose wood fibers by sanding, scraping or wire brushing. To ensure proper adhesion, weathered, dirty or mildewed surfaces should be cleaned with *OLYMPIC* Deck Cleaner prior to applying stain. After rinsing, allow wood to dry.

WARNING! If you scrape, sand, or remove old paint, you may release lead dust or fumes. LEAD IS TOXIC. EXPOSURE TO LEAD DUST OR FUMES CAN CAUSE SERIOUS ILLNESS, SUCH AS BRAIN DAMAGE, ESPECIALLY IN CHILDREN. PREGNANT WOMEN SHOULD ALSO AVOID EXPOSURE. FENCES, SIDING OR DECKS: Clean weathered, dirty or mildewed surfaces with *OLYMPIC* Deck Cleaner prior to applying product. Before use, be sure to read and follow the instructions and warnings on the label.

PRETEST: Test a small hidden area prior to application to ensure acceptable appearance and penetration.

PRIME: This product is self-priming over most substrates.

EXTRACTIVE BLEEDING: Some woods, such as cedar and redwood, contain high amounts of tannin, a colored wood extract. The first coat of stain may show some discoloration, but the tannins will be trapped in the first coat of stain. A second coat will result in a uniform appearance.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

Stir thoroughly before and often during use.

Application Method: Apply two thin coats. To help avoid lapmarks, apply to only a few boards at a time keeping a wet edge. Do not saturate or puddle on horizontal surfaces.

Application Equipment: Apply with a high quality brush, paint / stain pad or by spray equipment. When spraying, always back brush for best results. To help avoid lap marks, apply to only a few boards at a time, and maintain a wet edge. **Thinning:** DO NOT THIN.
