INSPIRED BY THE SPECTACULAR CAPE PALLISER LIGHTHOUSE ON THE SOUTHERNMOST TIP OF THE NORTH ISLAND OF NEW ZEALAND, EACH BOTTLE OF LIGHTHOUSE GIN CONTAINS A UNIQUE BLEND OF NINE BOTANICALS, INCLUDING THE FRESH ZEST OF YEN BEN LEMONS AND NAVEL ORANGES. WE HANDCRAFT OUR GIN WITH WATER THAT TRAVELS FROM HIGH IN THE REMUTAKA RANGES, FILTERING DOWN TO A SPRING BESIDE THE BREATHTAKING WHAREKAUHAU COUNTRY ESTATE IN PALLISER BAY.

THE LIGHTHOUSE

The Cape Palliser Lighthouse was imported from Birmingham in the late 1890s and erected in sections, one on top of the other, hauled up by cast-iron pulleys to the top of a seemingly inaccessible cliff where the aquamarine-blue ocean stretches all the way to Antarctica. On a clear day, you can occasionally glimpse the Kaikoura Mountains of the South Island.

LIGHTHOUSE GIN

Established in 2005, Lighthouse Gin is, first and foremost, a New Zealand gin. Founder and Master Distiller, Neil Catherall, spent several years researching and experimenting with various native botanicals until he ultimately selected a unique blend that included fresh zest of New Zealand-grown Navel oranges and Yen Ben lemons, the intensely flavored descendant of the famous Lisbon lemon.

Today, under the direction of Distiller Rachel Hall, Lighthouse Gin is double distilled in our custom made 200-litre copper still, which was specially built by local craftsmen. The double distillation process is time-consuming, but results in a softer, more refined and more approachable spirit, with each batch having its own subtle signature.

- BASE SPIRIT** Sugar cane
- STYLE** London Dry
- DISTILLATION** Double distilled
- STILL** Hand crafted copper pot still
- WATER** Spring water naturally filtered via the Remutaka Ranges
- BOTANICALS** Juniper, fresh Yen Ben lemon and Naval orange zest, Almond, Orris root, Cinnamon, Cassia bark, Licorice root, Coriander seed
- PROOF** 84 Proof (42% ABV)
- TASTE** Pure and complex with magnificent citrus and juniper accents. A finely spiced mid-palate and a soft, lingering finish.
