

Safety Alerts

Safety alerts identify potential hazards to avoid. The following safety alerts appear in this manual:



WARNING

Improper maintenance can cause injury. Do not use if parts are missing or damaged. Inspect regularly. Maintain according to the maintenance schedule in this manual.

Overloading the Pac Rac may cause injury or damage. Observe the 75 lb/34 kg load limit when placing items on the Pac Rac.

Limited Warranty

Ferno-Washington, Inc. ("Ferno"), warrants that its products will be free from defects in material and workmanship for one year except as follows:

- A) The warranty period on soft goods items is 90 days.
- B) The warranty period on repairs and services is 90 days.




Product Description

The Model 274 Pac Rac Instrument Platform (Pac Rac) is a cot-mounted device designed to support medical instruments (defibrillators, heart monitors, etc.) used by EMTs transporting a patient on a cot.

Pac Rac features include aluminum frame construction, flat-folding side panels for compact storage, cam-lock attachment, and straps to secure the instruments in place.


Cot Requirements

The Pac Rac fits 1 3/32" diameter main frame tubes spaced 20 1/4" to 20 3/4" apart (center to center).



There is a clearance of 6" - 7" for the patient's legs between the Pac Rac and the cot mattress.

Ferno cots which have the correct frame-tube diameter/spacing for Pac Rac attachment include Models 30, 29-M, and 35-A. Do not alter the Pac Rac or force the side panels to fit onto the cot. Product alteration or misfit can result in unpredictable operation and injury. Contact Ferno Customer Service if there is any question about fit.





Components



Pre-Service Check

Before placing the new Pac Rac in service, check the following:

- ☑ Do the side panels unfold/fold properly?
- Do the side panel braces lock properly?
- ☑ Does the Pac Rac fit on the cot properly?
- Do the straps hold the instruments securely?
- Do the cam-lock levers and cam-lock hooks engage and lock properly?

When everything checks properly, the Pac Rac is ready to use.

Using the Pac Rac

Guidelines for use

- The Pac Rac is for professional use only.
- Use the Pac Rac only as described in this manual.
- Have all users train and practice with the Pac Rac before placing the Pac Rac into regular service.
- Keep training records. A convenient form is provided in this manual (page 9).
- Use the Pac Rac only when it is properly maintained (page 7) and in good working order.
- Keep maintenance records. A convenient form is provided in this manual (page 9).

1 - Unfold the Pac Rac -

Lay the Pac Rac face down on the cot mattress or another flat surface.

Unfold the side panels (Fig. A) until the side panel braces click and lock into place.

Gently push on each unfolded side panel to verify that the panel braces are locked.



2 - Attach the Pac Rac to the cot

The Pac Rac attaches to the leg section of the cot (over the patient's legs) or to the midsection of the cot (over the patient's hips).

Decide on the position to use, then turn the Pac Rac face up and guide the positioning clips onto the cot frame at this location.

When attaching the Pac Rac to the leg section of the cot (Fig. B), keep in mind the top panel does limit elevation of the patient's legs.



Using the Pac Rac (continued)


To allow maximum elevation of the patient's legs, attach the Pac Rac to the midsection of the cot (Fig C). When attaching the Pac Rac to the midsection of the cot, be sure there is no interference with the use of patient restraints or operation of the cot sidearms.


To use the cam-lock hook, open the cam-lock lever. Swing the cam-lock hook under the frame tube and close the cam-lock lever (Fig. D).

An improperly secured Pac Rac may come off the cot and cause injury. Use the Pac Rac only when it is properly secured onto the cot.







3 - Secure instruments to the Pac Rac-

The Pac Rac is designed to carry instruments such as defibrillator/monitors weighing up to 75 lbs/34 kgs (Fig. E). Safely secure all items placed on the Pac Rac before transport.

It is the responsibility of the controlling EMS to devise the strapping methods for the particular instruments used by the EMTs.



WARNING



Overloading the Pac Rac may cause injury or damage. Observe the 75 lb/34 kg load limit when placing items on the Pac Rac.






Using the Pac Rac (continued)

Fold the Pac Rac

Unstrap and take all items off the Pac Rac. Unlock the cam-lock levers and remove the Pac Rac from the cot. Place the Pac Rac face down on a flat surface such as the cot mattress.

Press the side panel brace out to pop the brace button out of its detent (Fig. F). While maintaining pressure on the brace, fold the side panel downward. Repeat the preceding steps to fold the other side

panel.

The folded side panels overlap (Fig. G). Make sure the top side panel does not rest on the cam-lock hook of the bottom side panel. Slide the bottom panel cam-lock lever to allow the side panels to lie flat.

Before storing the Pac Rac, perform scheduled maintenance (below). Store the Pac Rac in a clean, dry place when not in use.



Scheduled Maintenance

Schedule	Procedure
After each use	Clean as needed with water and a mild detergent. Dry all parts with a soft cloth. When disinfection is required, follow the disinfectant manufacturer's directions for application and use.
Every 6 months	Inspect the Pac Rac. Apply a coating of light oil to the hinges and pivot points. Fold and unfold the Pac Rac to work lubricant into place. Should improper operation, damage, or missing parts be noted, take the Pac Rac out of service for repair.


