### Switch to the best... MIR Spirometry

*"Spirometry should be performed on all people 45 or older who currently smoke, are former smokers, or who are regularly exposed to environmental tobacco smoking or workplace irritants such as grain dust or cotton fibers. Testing should also be done in anyone with chronic cough, excess mucus, dyspnea on exertion or wheeze. In addition, anyone with a family history of emphysema or chronic bronchitis should have a spirometric test as a part of their data base"*

*(National Lung Health Education Program)*

CPT code 94060	PRE and POST-Bronchodilator administration, spirometry as in 94010	\$ 62
CPT code 94664	Bronchodilator administration	\$ 18
CPT code 94375	When flow volume loop is performed	\$ 40

#### SVC (VC) PROCEDURE

CPT code 94150	Slow vital capacity	\$ 25
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#### MVV PROCEDURE

CPT code 94200	Maximal Voluntary Ventilation	\$ 26
