Welcome to your magical Wizard's Adventure. Your child is about to embark on a journey filled with magic, creativity, and fun. However, they will need a little help from YOU to create the magic.



Inside this ADULTS ONLY package, you will find 7 numbered bags. Each bag contains a project or task for your child to complete. INSIDE each bag are 3 ELEMENTS:

1. A CARD explaining that particular step in the adventure
2. The PROJECT for the child to complete
3. Details of the TASK the child must do in order to progress to the next bag/surprise

Begin the Wizard Adventure with your child by first locating the introduction card and using the enclosed stickers to personalize the wizarding book. If your child does not know about this adventure yet, you may decide to add to the fun by surprising them by placing the book and stickers where they can happen upon them—as if placed there by magic.

Once they've personalized their wizarding book and completed the original task provided with it, you should secretly place the contents of BAG #1 into their wizarding book. It helps to leave the lid on the book open so they know there's something new and exciting inside. The pace of the adventure, reveal and task is up to you.

Once your child has completed the project and task for BAG #1, you can put the contents of BAG #2 into the wizarding book. Continue to do this, in order of bag numbers, finishing with BAG #7. (Make sure you fill in your child's name and the date on the certificate in bag #7!)

THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND:

Remind kids to be PATIENT, because magic takes time.

ENJOY the experience of orchestrating an adventure you and your child will never forget.

If your child asks, "what's inside that ADULTS ONLY envelope?," here are some truthful explanations:

- "An explanation of how the magic works. And a certificate that swears me to secrecy!"
- "Information about other adventure boxes."
- "Nothing important. Now let's get to wizarding."

Got it? Now get ready to embark on your MAGICAL ADVENTURE!

WAND INSTRUCTIONS

Color/paint the Alderberry wood wand and beads, use any color

Place the Phoenix Feather into the bottom of the bead

Slide the bead on the wand

Wrap the handle with the foam stickers

Place the bead on the bottom



Scroll Instructions

1. Cut the Magic Symbols from the bottom of the scroll.
2. Color the wood and beads
3. Weave the stick through the slots in the paper
4. Slide the Magic Symbols through the slits in the paper to decipher the code.
5. TO CLOSE: Fold suede cord in half and place one red seal sticker 5 inches down from the top. Flip over and place the other sticker on top.
6. Secure the scroll by pulling the red seal through the loop. Do not roll the scroll with the magic symbol paper inside.
