Severity	Likelihood (or frequency)
Extremely harmful (3)	Likely (3)
Harmful (2)	Unlikely (2)
Slightly harmful (1)	Highly unlikely (1)
Severity	Likelihood
Major (death or serious injury) (3)	High (harm is certain or near certain) (3)
Serious (over three days' absences) (2)	Medium (harm will occur frequently) (2)
Slight (up to three days' absence) (1)	Low (harm will seldom occur) (1)
Severity	Likelihood
No injury to person(s) (1)	Very unlikely (1)
Minor injury (2)	Chance of occurrence remote (2)
Major injury (3)	Probably could happen (3)
Serious involving long-term injury (4)	Definitely will occur (4)
Permanent disability/possibly death (5)

Low frequency, low consequence (L/L)	High frequency, high consequence (H/H)
Low frequency, high consequence (L/H)	High frequency, low consequence (H/L)
