Resource 13: Multiple intelligences

Verbal-linguistic	involves the ability to speak and write well, use language creatively and expressively
Logical-mathematical	ability to reason, calculate, use logical thinking
Visual-spatial	the ability to observe and discriminate closely, paint, use a map, express thoughts through drawings
Bodily-kinesthetic	ability to use one's hands or body competently and confidently, manipulate objects with dexterity
Musical/rhythmic- auditory	includes the ability to discern patterns in sounds and enjoy experimenting with them
Interpersonal	involves both verbal and non-verbal communication skills and includes the ability to relate to others
Intrapersonal	our ability to understand our inner self, to access and make sense of our thoughts, emotions and values
Naturalist	demonstrated in love of the outdoors, sensitivity to the natural environment
