We welcome you to bring your ideas, projects, experiments, artwork, research, models, board games, and more to present in our 1st Annual Geek Forest STEAM Fair with the community. The projects will be voted on and awarded to the top 5 that will be featured on our Geek Forest Website! This fair and contest is open to students ages 6-17, who will be divided into two separate age groups (6-11 & 12+) in all 5 Boroughs! However, due to limitations on space depending on how fast fair spots are filled up and the project type, the number of spots available for the contest will be capped so be sure to submit your proposals ASAP!

Project Specifications:

The project must revolve around a question within the STEAM fields, which is very broad, meaning the limits are endless as to what you can ask and research. For example, your question could be; "Is it Slime or is it Putty?", "Why is Sci-Art different from regular art"?, "What does the future of AI technology look like?", "Why is a 3D printed heart better than current replacements"...etc. It can be as simple or complex as you would like to make it. All projects must have some form of explanation/background information attached to it in the form of a project display board, poster board, or computer display. Each group is required to fill out a project proposal form and communicate with the fair committee when necessary for status updates. If you are a parent helping your child with their project you are included as a supporting member. All participants will be required to attend presentation day. Proposals/Entry Forms are due **May 1st, 2019 BY 5PM VIA EMAIL**. You will receive confirmation of your proposal being received and reviewed by May 15th, 2019 via email.
