OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

The First collection is powered by the Seiko VK64 mecha-quartz hybrid movement. Below is an overview of the functions of the movement.


- A) Crown/Time setting
 Pull out the crown fully and rotate the crown either clockwise or counter-clockwise to move the time forward or backwards respectively.
- B) Chronograph Start/Stop
 Push in the top pusher button to start or stop the central chronograph seconds hand.
- C) Chronograph Reset
 Push in the bottom pusher button to reset the central chronograph hand to 12 (zero).
 IMPORTANT DO NOT RESET THE CHRONO HAND UNLESS IT IS STOPPED. RESETTING
 WHILE IN OPERATION MAY CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE MOVEMENT.
- D) Chronograph Seconds Hand
 The central chronograph hand will beat 5 times per second when in operation. By default, the chrono seconds hand is reset to zero at the 12 o'clock position.

E) 24 Hour Indicator

The right sub-dial displays the current time in a simplified 24-hour format. The time displayed on this dial is linked to the main hour and minute hands and cannot be adjusted separately.

F) Chronograph 60 Minute Indicator

The left sub-dial displays a count of minutes accumulated while the central chrono hand has been in operation. A maximum of 60 minutes can be counted in one cycle.



Battery life: The standard battery life for the VK64 movement is 3 year.
