


CUSTOM BOW EQUIPMENT

VTX SCOPE INSTRUCTIONS



CHANGING PIN LOCATIONS

This scope housing has 8 pin mounting locations (2:A). To relocate the pin to another location, remove the threaded lens retaining ring from the housing (1:A). Next, pull the fiber ring (1:B) off of the housing (it may be necessary to pry this off) and rotate the brass plug (1:C) so that the #2-56 screws are accessible (2:B). Remove both of the #2-56 screws (1:D) and relocate the pin to the desired location. Reinstall the screws to fasten the pin in place and reinstall the fiber ring (1:B). Make sure that the fiber tube (1:E) remains in the brass plug.




MOUNTING LIGHT TO SCOPE

There are multiple ways that a light can be mounted to this sight. The base of the pin is threaded for an #8-32 sight light (3:A). First, remove the fiber ring (1:B). Next, as shown above remove the fiber tube from the brass plug and remove the brass plug (1:C). The fiber must be trimmed to length, so the light can be threaded into the pin. Trim the fiber so that it is slightly protruding from the bottom of the pin (3:A). The end of the fiber must then be flared for the best results. Install the light by threading it into the pin (3:B).



A 3/8"-24 sight light can also be threaded into the end of the scope tube (4:A), if the scope is being used with the CBE Vertex Elevate. There is a hole in the scope tube to route the fiber tube into the light (4:C). Pull the fiber tube out of one loop on the fiber tube ring (1:B) and run it through one of the holes on the scope tube (4:C).



MOUNTING SCOPE TO SIGHT

This scope has different mounting options for mounting it on multiple different sights. The scope comes assembled with the included CBE scope tube to be used with the CBE Vertex Elevate. There is also an adapter (5:A) provided for use with the CBE Vertex. To use this scope housing with a CBE Vertex, the adapter must be attached to the vertex windage tube using the #10-32 flat head screw provided with the sight (5:B). Next, remove the scope tube from the scope housing by removing the 2 #6-32 screws (4:B). Attach the adapter to the scope housing using the 2 #6-32 screws that were removed.

There is a #10-32 threaded rod included with the scope housing for use when the adapter will not work properly.
