

The Ridgeline Scarf

Designed by Team Love Fest

This simple pattern quickly knits up into a long, textural scarf. The ideal project for new knitters or anyone who loves the simple lines of garter stitch.

Materials + Notions:

- 1 x 50-yard bump of ReLove or Pure Love yarn (pictured here in Denim)
- US Size 50 straight needles
- Optional: Felting needle to weave in ends

Finished Measurements: Approximately 75" long x 5" wide

Abbreviations:

CO: cast on

BO: bind off

sts: stitches

STEP I:

- CO 4 sts, we used a simple half hitch CO

STEP II:

- Continue in knit stitch for 80+ rows (or until your scarf is at the desired length; 85 or so rows should use the full bump)

STEP III:

- BO and weave in ends (ends can be most easily disguised and held into place using a felting needle). You're done!
