The snorers' partners showed a 37 percent increase in overall sleep quality, a 33 percent increase in feeling rested upon waking up and a 31 percent increase in sleeping through the night without interruptions. Likewise, snorers claimed a 25 percent improvement in sleep quality, 30 percent increase in feeling rested upon awakening and 20 percent increase in the ability to sleep through the night.

Additionally, 78 percent of snorers expressed that Smart Nora is a better solution compared to other solutions they've tried and 90 percent of the couples agreed that Smart Nora is easy to use and fits right into their nightly routine.
