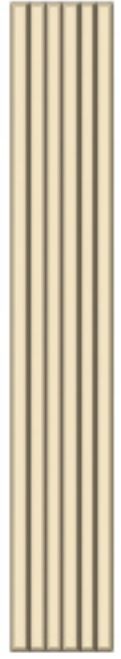


# What's in the Kit

6 Grip Strips on backing paper



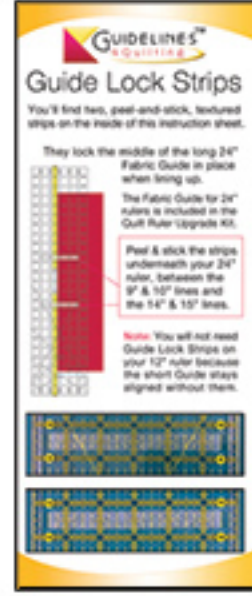
12" Fabric Guide



24" Guide Folded in Half

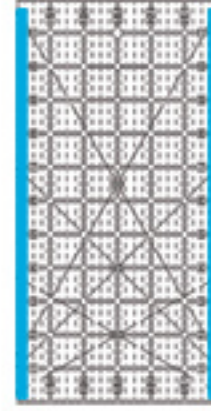


2 Guide Lock Strips in the instruction sheet

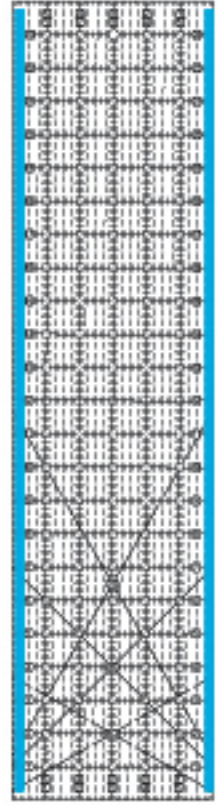


# 1) Attach Grip Strips

Peel the clear Grip Strips off the brown backing paper and attach them right up to the edge along the long sides underneath your rulers.

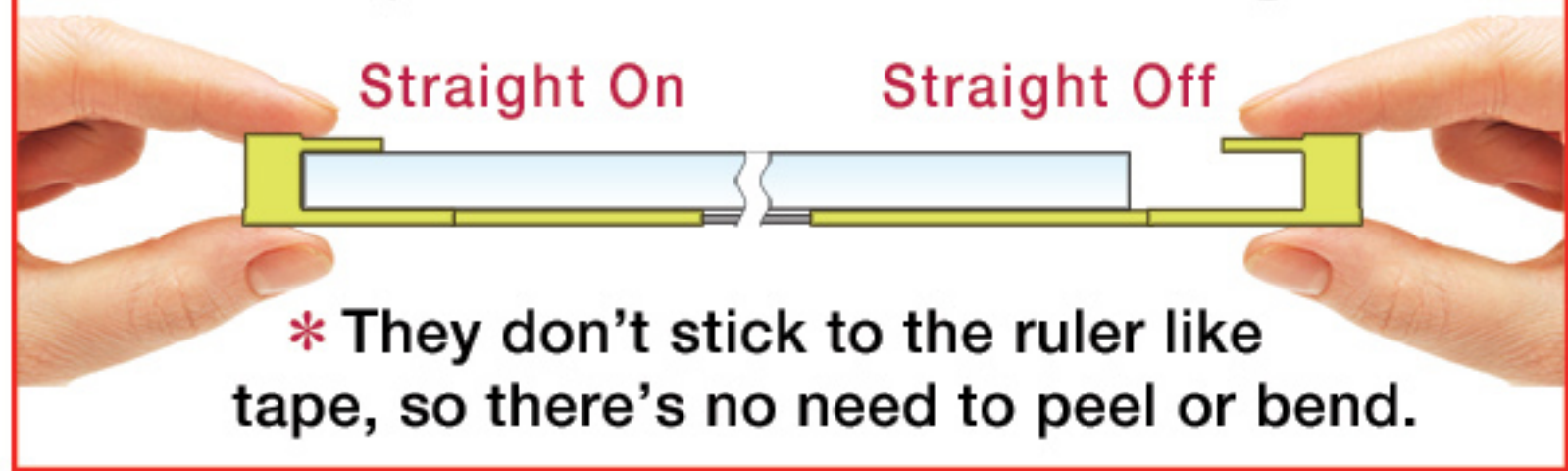


Put one on each edge of your 12" ruler and two on each edge of your 24" ruler.

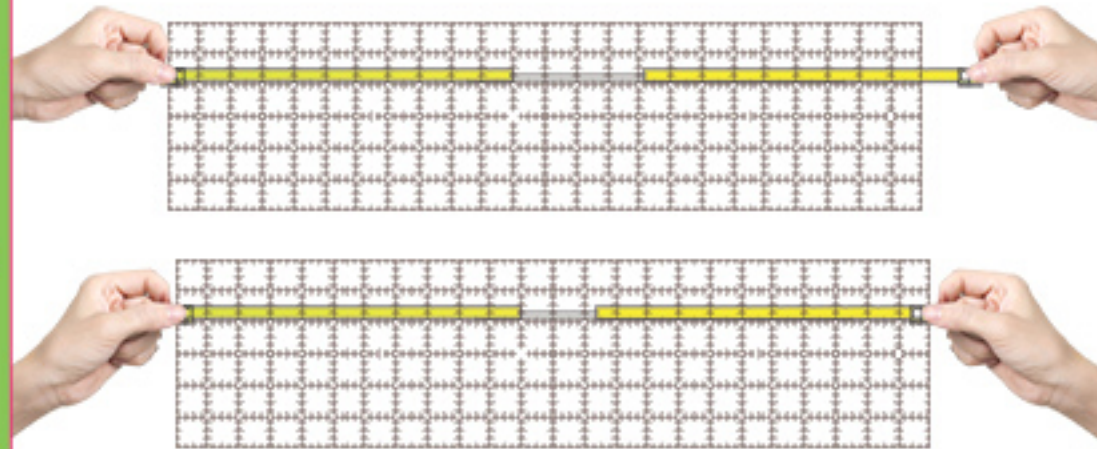


# 2) Attach Guide Lock Strips and Clip on Fabric Guides

\* Keep the Fabric Guides Straight.

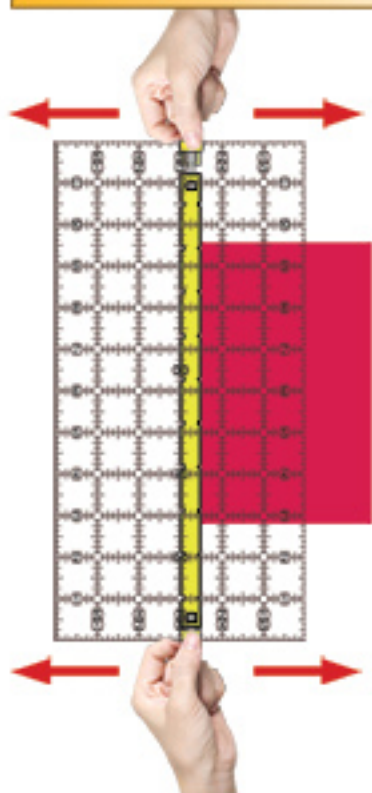


Refer to the instruction sheet & attach the Guide Lock Strips underneath your 24" or 24½" ruler.



Clip one end of the Guide onto the short end of a 12" or 24" ruler. Pull on the other hook to stretch the band until you can clip the other hook on the other end of the ruler.

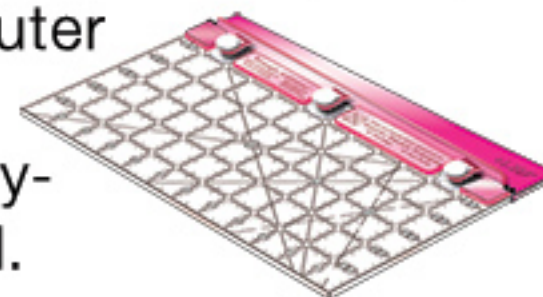
# 3) Slide the Fabric Guide by the hooks to the line you want.



Then slide the ruler over the fabric until the Guide's edge catches the fabric's edge. (Left-handers can line up to the left side of the Guide.)

# Get More Grip Strips

If you are using Additions, be sure to attach Grip Strips to their outer edges to keep everything level.
