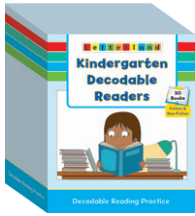
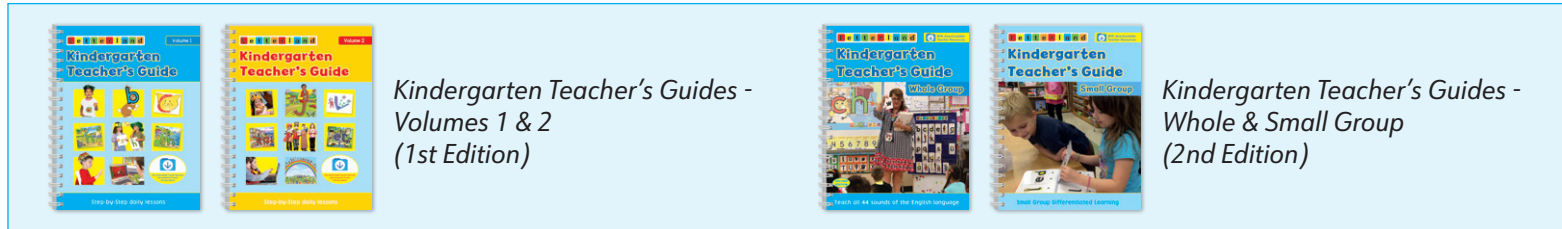


# Kindergarten Decodable Readers Scope

 These words are phonetically decodable, but students may find them more challenging as they have two syllables or consonant blends.

### Tricky Words

High-frequency words that can't be fully decoded using the phonic knowledge the student knows at this stage of learning.

### New Tricky Words

When the Tricky Word is first introduced in the *Kindergarten Decodable Readers*. Note the word will always have been introduced in the *Kindergarten Teacher's Guide* lesson prior to it appearing in the *Kindergarten Decodable Reader*.
