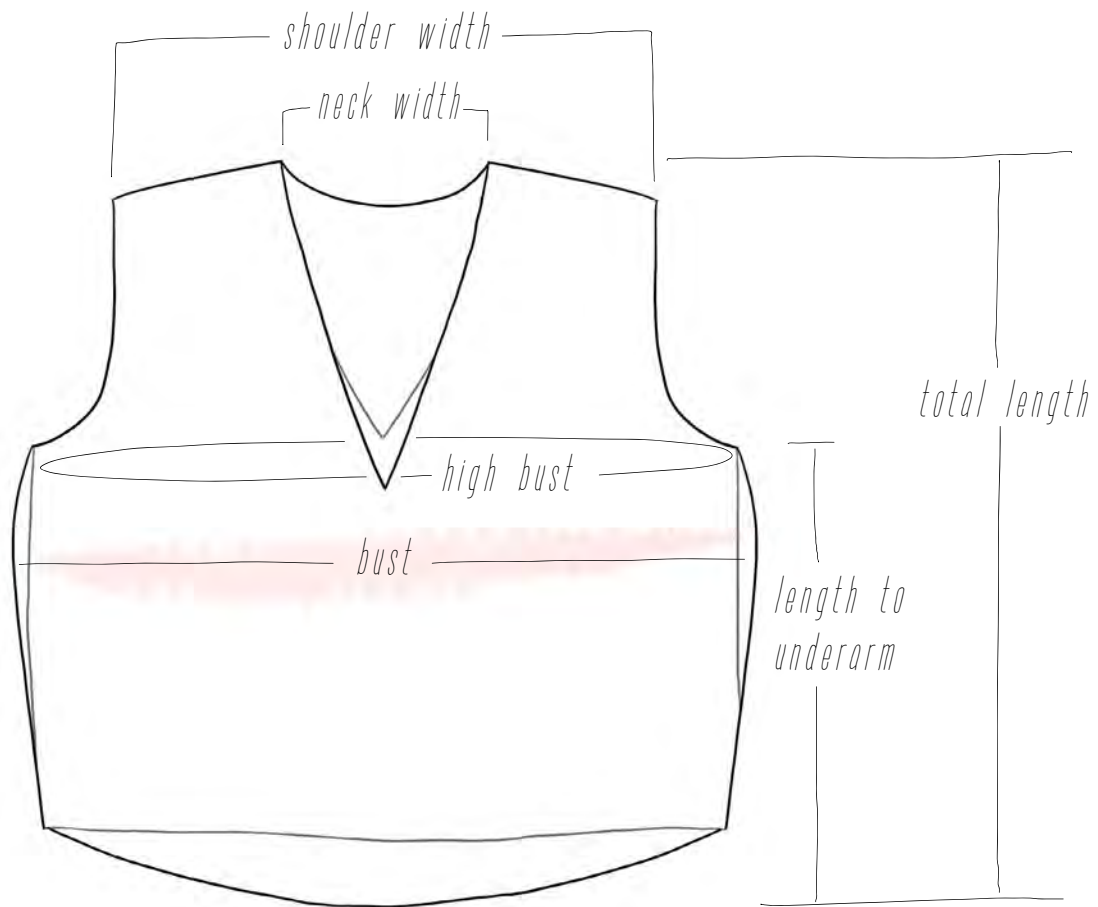

# SCHEMATIC



Grey outline shows the v-neck depth for A-D cups, the front shape for A-B cups, and the back shape for all variations.

The black outline shows the v-neck depth for E-H cups and the front shaping for G-H cups. The pink shaded area represents the extra fabric which is added with short rows at the bust, and which will lower the centre of the hem when the garment is laid flat. It will hang level when worn.

Note that the proportions between the shoulder and chest width vary across the size range. Smaller sizes will have a straighter armhole than shown in the schematic, while larger sizes will have a more dramatic curve in the armhole than shown.

Some sport/lighter DK weight yarns may also work well for a slightly looser, drapier fabric.
