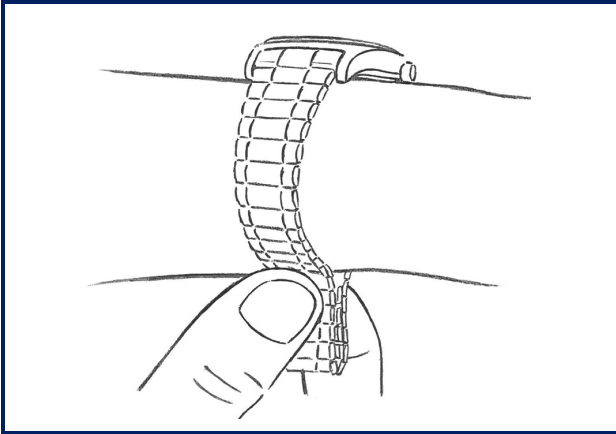


# CARAVELLE

## Expansion Band Sizing Guide

Step 1

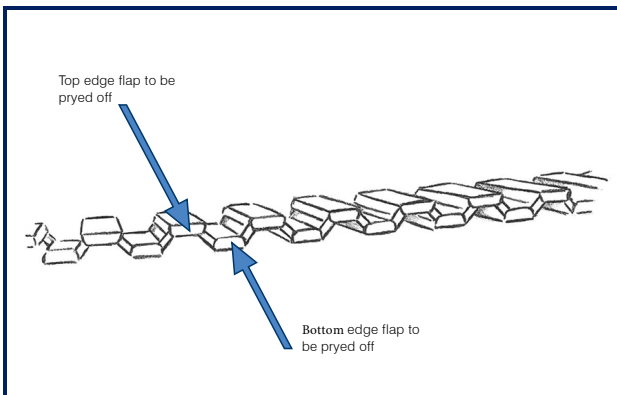


- Measure the watch band. Before you set about removing any watch links, it is necessary to measure your watch band so you know exactly how many links you will need to remove.

To do this: Position the watch on your wrist exactly the way you intend to wear it.

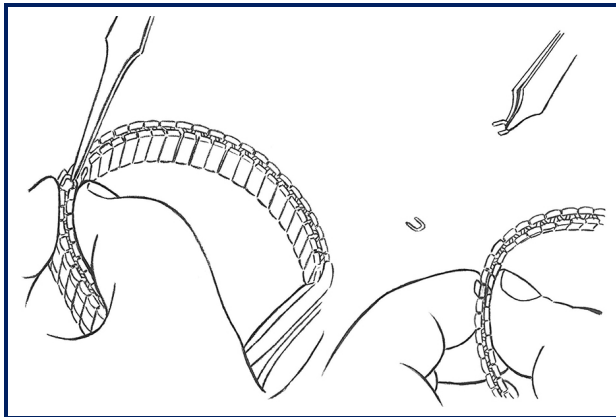
- With the watch band on your wrist, gather the slack in the band and hold the links together to simulate them being removed
- Count the number of links you have gathered and subtract "2" from the number. The total will tell you the amount of links needing to be removed.  
Example: 6 links gathered to fit of wrist , subtract 2 = total 4 links to be removed
- If you can't accurately judge the number of links to remove, remove one less than you expect - it is always easier to remove another link than add one back in.

Step 2



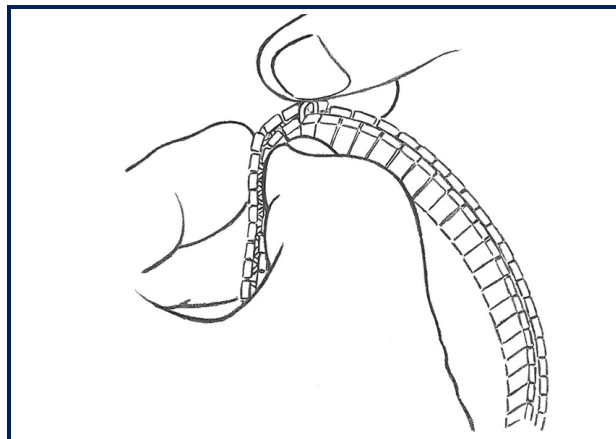
- Use a tweezer or small flat screwdriver to pry open the side edge flaps of the link to be removed.

Step 3



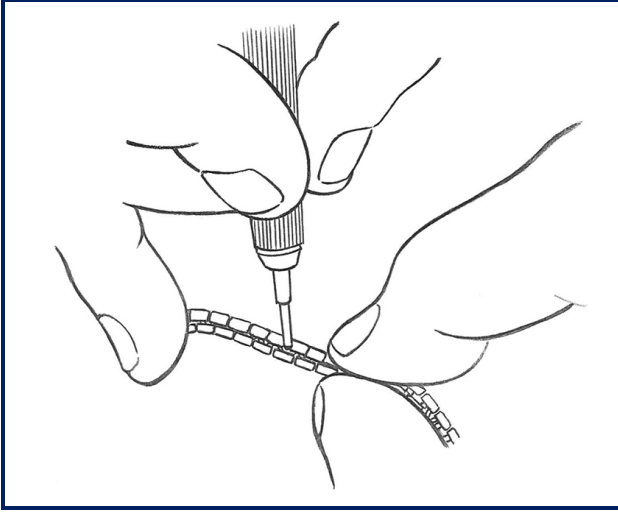
- Use the tweezers to remove the U shape pin that secures the links at either side of the bracelet.
- Place the pin in your parts tray, you will need it to put the bracelet back together again.
- Multiple links can also be removed at the same time by grouping and removing the pins at each end.

Step 4



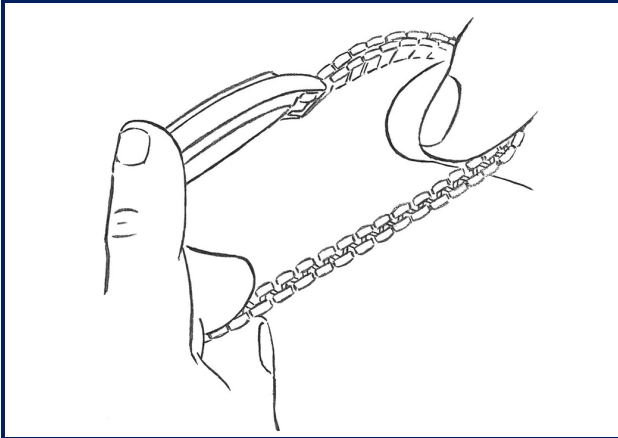
- To reconnect the separated bracelet, align the link to reconnect and insert the U shape pins back into the links of both side.

Step 5



- With the help of screwdriver, engage the pins on both sides simultaneously and push down to close the top and bottom flaps, re-connecting the bracelet.

Step 6



- Watch will then be reconnected with desired length.
