THE CATTY CAROUSEL CARDIGAN

The Catty Carousel Cardigan is a fitted cardigan with a bold carousel-inspired colourwork yoke, and little colourwork sparkles at the neck, wrists and hem.

SIZING

This cardigan is designed to be worn quite fitted, with around 5cm of positive ease. If you prefer a looser knit, though, you can size up. Check the **adjustments** section for some guidance around this

SCHEMATIC

Measurements d (waist) and e (hips) only refer to the cardigan with waist shaping.





GAUGE

28 sts and 36 rows to 10cm, in stocking stitch, measured on a washed, blocked swatch.

Check your gauge on both plain and colourwork knitting - you may need to switch up or down a needle size for the colourwork.

Getting the correct gauge is crucial for a well-fitting cardigan. If you're struggling to get both row and stitch gauge spot on you should prioritise the stitch gauge.

I used a 3mm needle to obtain gauge.

All measurements are in centimteres, and are for the completed garment. You should choose the size that gives you the correct ease.

YARN

The sample here used an An Caitin Beag advent calendar from 2022, in the Landlocked colourway.

The yarn is Merino Fingering, a 4ply merino yarn, with 400m per 100gr.

CHOOSING A YARN.

This knit wants a 4ply, garment-suitable yarn.

Non-superwash wool will make steeking your cardigan much easier and less stressful.

Even if you're not planning to steek your cardigan a wool or woolblend yarn is best for colourwork.

CHOOSING COLOURS

You need a strong contrast between CC2 - that's the white in the sample shown - and both of the other shades, but CC1 and MC don't need any contrast at all - and you can use the same shade for both if you like.

I like to temper the colour chaos of a gradient with a little bit of neutral yarn. Here I've used a mid-grey for CC2 to do that.

All yarn requirements are in metres. Yarn requirements include a 10% contingency to allow for swatching and for small variations in gauge.



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
