
About Parents as Teachers:

What is Home Visiting?

Home visiting is a **FREE** and **VOLUNTARY** service that helps parents and caregivers raise children who are physically, socially, and emotionally healthy and ready to learn. Parents as Teachers is one of the evidence-based home visiting programs available in Idaho.

How can home visiting help?

- Increase your knowledge of early childhood development and positive parenting practices.
- 2. Improve your child's health and development.
- Provide early screening for developmental delays and offer resources.
- 4. Increase your child's school readiness and academic success.
- 5. Help you access useful services and community resources.
- 6. Help strengthen your relationships with your child, your family, and your friends.



How do home visits work?

- We schedule a visit with you at a convenient time and place for each of us. It can be in your home, another place you feel comfortable, or sometimes on a virtual platform.
- Our visits are with you and your child and usually last one hour.

- We teach you fun activities to do with your child that promote early learning and development.
- Together, we talk about your child's development and offer screenings to make sure your child is on track.
- We help you set goals for your family and connect you to resources to help you meet those goals.
- We provide information and answer questions about your child's development or other issues you may be worried about.
- Our program will offer opportunities to connect with other parents and families through Group Connection activities on a regular basis.
