

## Petpost!

When possible, we use natural and organic ingredients including organic beeswax. This makes Petpost Paw Protect gentler than products made from harsh chemicals.

Paw Protect is made in the United States by an environmentally-conscious company with naturally-derived ingredients and recyclable packaging, so it's good for the environment as well as good for your dog.

#### Why worry about my dog's paws?

While wolves can walk on any terrain without problems, domestic dogs have spent too long indoors. Their pads aren't naturally prepared for harsh conditions. Petpost paw protect applies a waxy layer of protection to Fred's feet to keep him safe from the elements.







#### Instructions:

The Petpost Paw Protect is easy and convenient to use. Follow these instructions to help protect your dog's paw pads.

- 1. Gather your supplies! In addition to the Petpost Paw Protect, you will want a handy way to distract your dog from licking the balm off his feet while you are applying it. You don't want to give him time to lick his paws!
- 2. Uncap the Paw Protect and rub the product directly on the outside of your dog's paws. Apply generously, making sure to get in between each paw pad and giving special attention to any sore spots that you can see.
- 3. Place the cap back on the Paw Protect and immediately begin your walk. His first instinct will be to lick the strange (and apparently delicious) new stuff off his paws, but it won't help protect your dog's feet if he licks it all off!
- **4.** Take a walk! Did someone say walk?
- 5. Reapply as needed. As a general rule of thumb, you should apply Paw Protect to Little Pickle's paws every 30 minutes of walk time.

6. Use before any walk in which conditions are less than ideal. Road salt, ice melt, snow, gravel, and hot pavement are examples of things that can hurt, crack, or even cut Hazel's paw pads. Paw Protect provides a protective layer on your dog's feet without ugly booties.



#### FAQ:

The Petpost Paw Protect is pretty straightforward, but there are a few questions that frequently come up. Follow these instructions to help protect your dog's paw pads from ice, snow, salt, or hot pavement for walks in any weather.

#### Q: How quickly after applying Paw Protect can I go on a walk?

A: You can take FlufferNutter on a walk immediately after applying Paw Protect. You should apply the product close to the door so you can go right outside without losing any wax inside your house. Make sure to bring it with you so you can reapply as needed!

#### Q: How do I distract my dog while I'm applying the Paw Protect?

A: There's a few great methods to distracting Winnie while applying the Paw Protect to your dog's paws. It is helpful to have a partner if your dog is extra wiggly. Our favorite distraction is simply giving your dog an extra delicious treat that distracts her for a few minutes. A peanut butter filled bone is a great, time consuming treat, but a bully stick or other chewy food will work too. If your dog is not very food motivated, then pull out your dog's favorite tug toy, chew toy, or squeaking plush toy to chew on for a minute. Neither of these are working for you? How about having your partner give the most coveted form of doggy affection: the belly rub!

#### Q: Should I rinse with water after using this product?

A: Nope! We want your dog's paws to be as protected as possible, so there is no need to rinse before your walk! If your dog still has some of the waxy stuff on her paws after the walk, you can go ahead and rinse. Have you tried our Paw Wipes? They are perfect for this kindof thing...

#### Q: This product isn't working for me, what should I do?

A: This product works for most dogs. In almost every case that this product doesn't work, it is because Moose is too squirmy to let you put enough of the good stuff on his paws. If that is the case, try training your dog to accept paw touching by giving an extra special treat every time he lets you touch a paw, and gradually going from there. If you are consistent and patient - this product will work for you! We are so sure of it, that we offer a 100% money-back guarantee.
