


The Petpost Paw Wipes are easy and convenient to use. Follow these instructions to clean, soothe, and heal your dog's paw pads.

- 1. Shake the canister of paw wipes before use. The best stuff tends to settle in the bottom of the jar, so a good shake will help ensure that each wipe is thoroughly coated with our natural ingredients.
- 2. Gently hold one of Zoe's feet and wipe it thoroughly, making sure to get the top of the foot, in between the toes, and even between the paw pads. Pay special attention to any areas that are extra dry or cracked.
- 3. Repeat with all 4 feet (unless, of course, you have an awesome tripawd!) If Maximus is fidgety, make sure to give him plenty of treats in between each foot. You want him to learn that the sight of the canister means he'll be getting yummy treats in return for holding still while you wipe down his feet.
