Vinyl Mat Cleaning Instructions

General Cleaning Maintenance

- Your mats should be lightly washed from time to time using warm water (< 130° F)
- Do not soak the mats or leave standing water on the mats
- If necessary, use a very mild, non-abrasive detergent such as Dawn Liquid Dish Detergent and always spot test a small patch first
- · A general rule of thumb is one firm squirt of mild soap per bucket of warm mop water
- Always make sure to use a clean 100% cotton mop and ensure it does not have any residue from previous use
- · Change out the mop water and mild soap solution when it becomes cloudy or dirty
- · Continue to clean the mat surface until the mop water remains clear when wringing out the mop

Dirt and Grime Cleaning

- For heavier duty cleaning of dirt and grime, use a solution of warm water and citrus degreaser such as Zep Heavy Duty Citrus Degreaser
- Mix a solution of 4 oz of citrus degreaser per 1 gallon of warm water
- Do not soak the mat or leave a standing solution on the mat for more than 5 minutes
- Always spot test a small patch first and make sure to use a clean 100% cotton mop and ensure it does not have any residue from previous use
- Change out the citrus degreaser solution when it becomes cloudy or dirty
- Continue to clean the mat surface until the mop water remains clear when wringing out the mop

Mat Disinfection Cleaning

• After cleaning your mat and during use of the mats, be sure to use a surface disinfectant such as Dollamur Mat Cleaner Athletic Surface Disinfectant for disinfection and control of mold and mildew. Follow the directions on the disinfectant cleaner bottle to insure continuous protection.
