
Section D - Pictures

Having actual pictures of your feet will greatly help our Pointe Shoes fitters find the right pair of Pointe Shoes for you.


Please take a look at the sample pictures below, and using a digital camera, or your phone, please replicate these positions and send the pictures to us, along with your completed form.

Section E - Outline of Dancer's Feet

We need to get an outline of your foot with specific measurements. Please review the instructions below and use the charts on the next pages, one for your right foot and the other for your left foot.

Important:


- Make sure that your feet are bare, not wearing tights or socks.
- Make sure that you are standing up and that your foot is bearing your weight when you are tracing it.

How to trace your feet:

- Tracing one foot at a time, place the paper with the grid on a nice flat surface, then precisely put your foot within the grid area on the page, the heel should be lined up with the mark, at the bottom of the page, and your toes toward the top of the graph.
- Make sure that your entire foot is within the graph lines.
- Using a pen, holding it in a vertical position, trace a clean outline of your foot. Do not use a pencil, as it will not be visible enough, nor use a felt marker as the line will bleed.

How to measure your feet:

- Referring to the diagram below, please take both measurements for each of your foot.
- You can use a measuring tape or a ruler.
- On each diagram, for each foot, enter the information from your measurements.
- Measure your actual foot, do not measure the outline of your foot on the diagram.



First measurement:

Measure the length of your foot, from the tip of your toe to the back of the heel.

Second measurement:

Measure the width of your foot, from the metatarsal joints on each side of your foot.




