BROOME artist Helen Norton will travel south to Margaret River for her exhibition *Butterflies, Bulls and Angels*.

Melbourne-born Norton, a self-taught artist, settled in Broome in 1986 and exhibits around the country.

She sees herself as a "reporter of the human condition" more than an artist.
