

# Information Sheet - Helen Norton Giclee Artwork on Paper or Canvas

## PRESENTATION SUGGESTIONS:



Your Canvas Giclee is posted to you unframed, and rolled in a tube. It is printed with a 50 mm plain colour border. The border is neutral to the image. (see images on the left).

Some ideas for getting it on the wall:

You could have it stretched over 32-35mm deep pine stretcher bars. This is the most affordable option and will give you a contemporary clean look, and a light easy to hang artwork.

Or, you might have it framed in a traditional manner with a frame of your choice for a magnificent result that makes it hard to distinguish your print from an original.

All artworks are numbered and signed on the back by the artist.

We have included a few pics below to show you how it may turn out.

A shot from our gallery below showing some large (92x92cm) Canvas Giclees hanging. These are over pine bars. You can see the neutral edges, and remember if the artwork is smaller, the bar will look more chunky and substantial.



## WHAT IS A GICLEE PRINT?

Modern computer technology and advances in the printing process have resulted in a revolution in the world of artistic printmaking and a change in the preferred way for galleries and publishers to make reproduction prints. The Giclee process uses extremely fine droplets of ink that are transferred with incredible precision to heavy water-colour paper or canvas. Computer technology ensures that these droplets produce a resolution that is significantly finer than that obtained by conventional printing.
