



RING SIZE FINDER

FINDING YOUR RING SIZE

1. Find a ring that current fits
2. Match the inside of the ring to the outside of the closest circle.
3. If the ring falls between two sizes, order the larger
4. Double check for size accuracy.

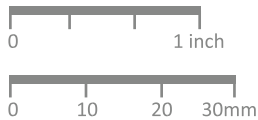
IF YOU'RE BUYING THE RING AS A SURPRISE

1. Ask a recipient's friend if they know their ring size.
2. Borrow a recipient's rings and measure as above.

OTHER TIPS AND INFORMATION

- If your knuckle is a lot larger than the base of your finger, measure both the base of your finger and your knuckle and select a size between the two.
- When considering a wide band, move up a size from your measurement, for comfort's sake.
- Your ring size will be about half a size larger on the hand you write with.
- Measure your finger in warm temperatures at the end of the day.
- If you are unsure you've found the right size, we can send a set of plastic ring to try on.

CONFIRM PRINTED SCALE



1. Prior to printing, ensure that page scaling is set to "None" in the print dialog box.
2. Measure the scale bar on the left to ensure it is exactly 1 inch or 30mm long. If the measurement is not accurate, check that you are printing the page at full size and reprint before continuing.
