

EC 1935/2004 REQUIREMENT FOR SILICONE

TYM Limited has a Quality Management System that is certified to ISO9001:2015 and operates full batch traceability of all ingredients and production processes from Despatch note to supplier batch identification. This means that TYM Limited complies with the good manufacturing practice regulation 2023/2006

We do not apply the "glass and fork" recommended food contact logo on any of our products at this time, due to the unavailability of a food safe ink that can be applied to silicone products.

In the current absence of EU legislation which specifies the requirements to prove that a silicone article is safe for food contact, we have conducted extraction testing to the requirements of FDA 21CFR 177.2600 "Rubber articles intended for repeated contact with foodstuff" and BfR XV "Silicones" on the above materials to support the statement that our silicones are safe for food contact.
