 A successful applicant accepts the grant with the explicit understanding that in the event the applicant discontinues his or her studies during the period for which the grant was made, M&T may, at its sole discretion, require repayment of all or part of the total grant. 					
• The number, size, and timing of grants are determined by <i>M&T</i> and the decisions are final.					
• <i>M&T</i> will work with each recipient to set a deadline for the final research essay, which will be published in a subsequent edition of <i>Mortise & Tenon Magazine</i> .					
• The recipient will be in regular contact with <i>M&T</i> as the research progresses, and excerpts from this correspondence may be published on the <i>M&T</i> blog and shared with grant donors.
