

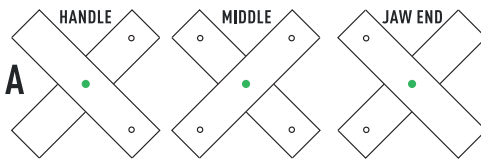
HOW TO

MAKE YOUR OWN DINO JAWS

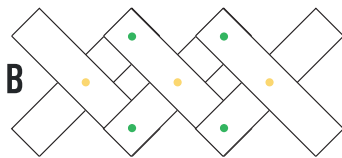
- Using a ruler and the tip of a biro or similar tool, score quite heavily along the dotted lines. Then fold along these score lines.
- With the help of an adult, carefully cut along the solid grey lines. You should now have 6 rectangles with a fold in the middle, and the 2 parts of dinosaur head.
- Now poke holes where the grey circles are, place some of your C+C mail packaging under your rectangles, and using a wooden skewer or biro pen poke firmly through the card, repeat for all.
- Now take a folded rectangle and apply a generous amount of pritt stick to the printed side. Press closed firmly and place under a heavy book, repeat for all 6. Glue will dry in a few minutes.

5 Time to join the links:

A. Take the two rectangles that belong together, and push a metal fastener through the centre holes as green dots below. Open the arms on the fasteners and bend back flat onto the card for each one.



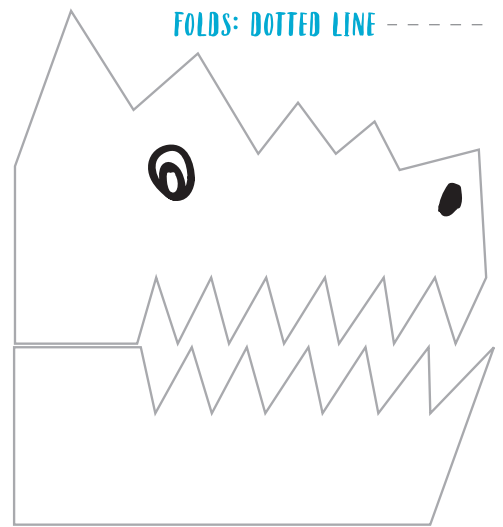
B. Join the 3 parts from image A where the green dots show, as image B.



6 With your moving parts complete, lay out as below image. Stick the top and bottom jaw in place, allow glue to dry for a few mins and that's it **YOU'RE DONE!!**

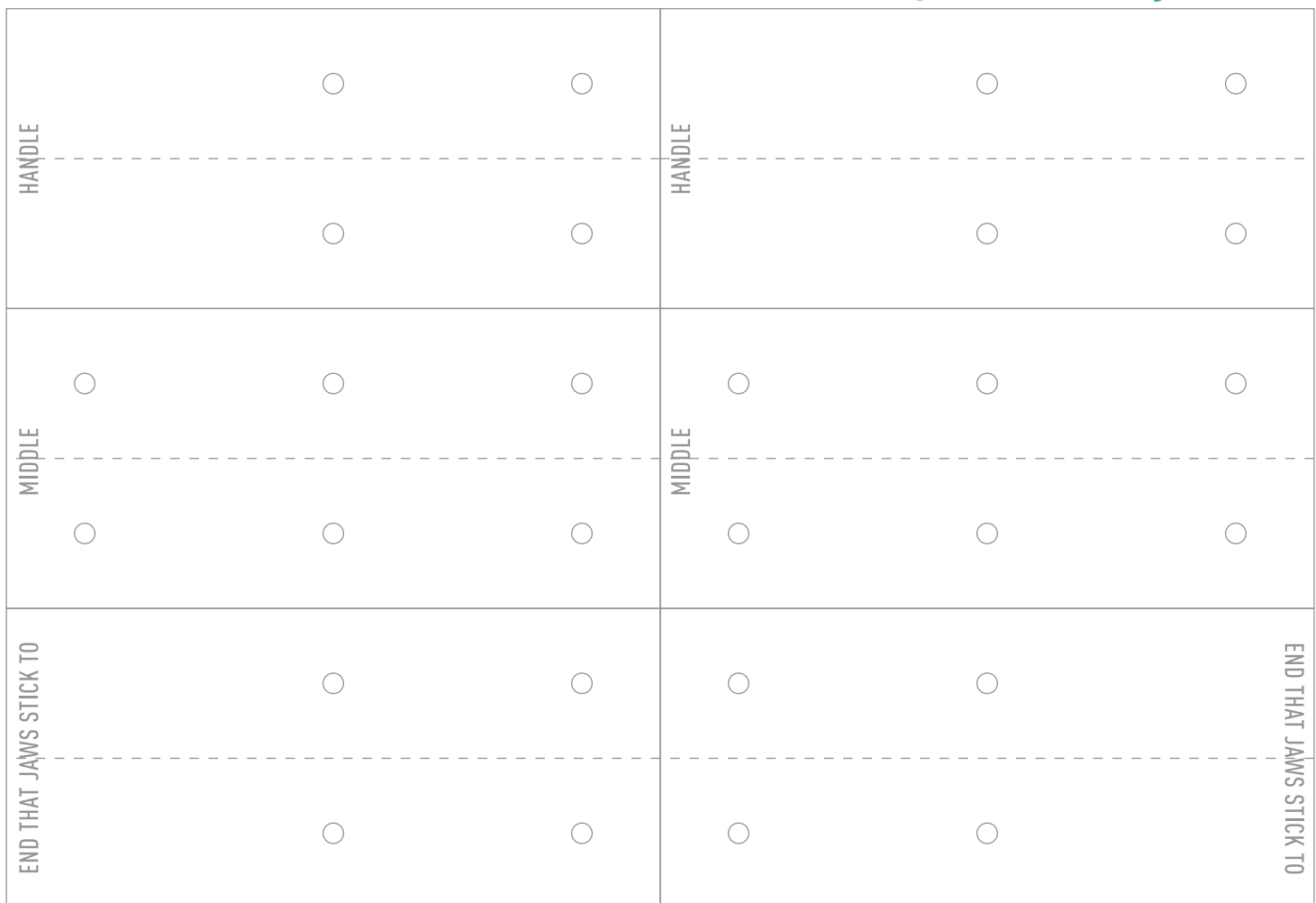


CUTS: SOLID LINE ———
