C-VUE STAND PARTS LIST

Door Hinges Camlocks Camlock Screws ½" Hinge Screws 1" Cabinet Foot Screws Plastic Cabinet Feet Stand Panels

Special Note on installing Camlock screws

When installing camlock screws into pre-installed nylon adapters. Be sure not to over tighten, or cams will not engage correctly.

Thread camlock screws straight up and down as possible and only screw in just to the point where you cannot see thread any more. If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.


Over tightening the camlock screws can also cause damage to the outer finish of stand, this kind of damage is not covered by warranty.

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
C-VUE 18, 26, 45 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1- Attaching Right Side Panel to Back Panel

[requires two (2) Camlocks and two (2) Camlock Screws]



- Insert two (2) Camlock Screws into the Right Side Panel.
 - Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.
- Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Back Panel
- Attach Right Side Panel into the Back Panel
- Tighten Camlocks to secure the Right Side Panel to Back Panel.
 - If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.



Step 3- Attaching Bottom Panel to Stand

[requires six (6) Camlocks and six (6) Camlock Screws]

•Insert six (6) Camlock Screws into the Bottom Panel.

•Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Right Side Panel

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Left Side Panel

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Back Panel

• Attach Bottom Panel to Cabinet

• Tighten Camlocks to secure the Bottom Panel to the Cabinet

• If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.

Step 2- Attach Left Side Panel to Back Panel

[requires two (2) Camlocks and two (2) Camlock Screws]

• Insert two (2) Camlock Screws into the Left Side Panel.


• Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.


• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Back Panel.

• Attach the Left Side Panel to the Back Panel.

• Tighten Camlocks to secure the Left Side Panel to Back Panel.

• If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.





Step 5- Attaching the Top Panel to the Cabinet

[requires eight (8) Camlocks and eight (8) Camlock Screws]

•Insert eight (8) Camlock Screws into the Top Panel.

• Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Left Side Panel

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Right Side Panel

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Back Panel

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Front Support Brace

• Place the Top Panel on the Cabinet Tighten the Camlocks to secure the Top Panel to the Cabinet

• If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.

Step 4- Attaching Front Panel to Stand

[requires two (2) Camlocks and two (2) Camlock Screws]

• Insert two (2) Camlock Screws into the Front Panel.

• Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.


•Insert one(1) Camlocks into the Right Side Panel


•Insert one (1) Camlocks into the Left Side Panel

•Attach Front Panel to Cabinet

•Tighten Camlocks to secure the Bottom Panel to the Cabinet

• If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.





Step 6- Insert Shelf into stand [requires four (4) shelf holders]

- Insert four (4) shelf holders into pre-drilled holes.
- Press in firmly, you may need to tap lightly with hammer.
- Place shelf onto shelf holders




Step 7- Attaching Hinges [requires four (4) ¹/₂" screws]


- Attach the Hinges to the Left Side Panel and Right Side Panel
- Line up hinges with pilot holes and secure with 1/2" screws.
 - Be sure to make screws with tight snug fit, but do not over tighten.

Step 8- Installing the door

[requires four (4) ¹/₂" screws]

- Mount Door to the Hinge on the Side Panel using ½" screws.
- Line up hinges with pilot holes and secure with 1/2" screws.
 - Be sure to make screws with tight snug fit, but do not over tighten.





Step 9- Installing the cabinet feet

[requires four [4] cabinet feet and four (4) 1" cabinet feet screws]

- Align feet with pilot holes
- Secure with 1" screws.


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• Be sure to make screws with tight snug fit, but do not over tighten.

C-VUE 40 ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS

Step 1- Attaching Right Side Panel to Back Panel

[requires two (2) Camlocks and two (2) Camlock Screws]



- Insert two (2) Camlock Screws into the Right Side Panel.
 - Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.
- Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Back Panel
- Attach Right Side Panel into the Back Panel
- Tighten Camlocks to secure the Right Side Panel to Back Panel.
 - If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.

Step 2- Attach Left Side Panel to **Back Panel**

[requires two (2) Camlocks and two (2) Camlock Screws]

• Insert two (2) Camlock Screws into the Left Side Panel.


• Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.


 Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Back Panel.

 Attach the Left Side Panel to the Back Panel.

• Tighten Camlocks to secure the Left Side Panel to Back Panel.

• If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.





Step 3- Attaching Bottom Panel to Stand

[requires eight (8) Camlocks and eight (8) Camlock Screws]

•Insert eight (8) Camlock Screws into the Bottom Panel.

•Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the **Right Side Panel**

 Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Left Side Panel

• Insert four (4) Camlocks into the Back Panel

• Attach Bottom Panel to Cabinet

• Tighten Camlocks to secure the Bottom Panel to the Cabinet

 If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with ₉ cam.

Step 4- Attaching Front Panel to Stand

[requires two (2) Camlocks and two (2) Camlock Screws]

• Insert two (2) Camlock Screws into the Front Panel.

• Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.


•Insert one(1) Camlocks into the Right Side Panel

•Insert one (1) Camlocks into the Left Side Panel

•Attach Front Panel to Cabinet


•Tighten Camlocks to secure the Bottom Panel to the Cabinet

• If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.



Step 5- Attaching the Top Panel to the Cabinet

[requires twelve (12) Camlocks and twelve (12) Camlock Screws]



•Insert twelve (12) Camlock Screws into the Top Panel.

• Be sure to screw in just until the threads are not visible, no more.

• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Left Side Panel


• Insert two (2) Camlocks into the Right Side Panel

• Insert four (4) Camlocks into the Back Panel

• Insert four (4) Camlocks into the Front Support Brace

• Place the Top Panel on the Cabinet Tighten the Camlocks to secure the Top Panel to the Cabinet

• If cam will not engage during assembly, then you must unscrew the camlock screw slightly until the head of the screw and engage with cam.




Step 7-Installing middle support beam.

[requires four (4) 1/2" screws and two (2) angle brackets

• Place beam inside stand on front edge and behind top front panel.

- Line up angle bracket with pilot holes
- Secure with 1/2" screws.
 - Be sure to make screws with tight snug fit, but do not over tighten.






Step 8- Attaching Hinges [requires eight (8) ½" screws]


- Attach the Hinges to the Left Side Panel and Right Side Panel
- Line up hinges with pilot holes and secure with 1/2" screws.
 - Be sure to make screws with tight snug fit, but do not over tighten.

Step 9- Installing the doors

[requires eight (8) ¹/₂" screws]

- Mount Door to the Hinge on the Side Panel using ½" screws.
- Line up hinges with pilot holes and secure with 1/2" screws.
 - Be sure to make screws with tight snug fit, but do not over tighten.





Step 10- Installing the cabinet **feet** [requires four [4] cabinet feet and four (4) 1" cabinet feet screws]

- Align feet with pilot holes Secure with 1" screws.

• Be sure to make screws with tight snug fit, but do not over tighten.
